1. <u>ACT-2024-141</u> <u>ACT-HUD Application for Grant Funds</u>

AN ACT authorizing the County of Westchester to submit an application to the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development for grant funds from the Community Development Block Grant Program, HOME Investment Partnerships Program and the Emergency Solutions Grants Program, submit the Five Year 2024-2028 Consolidated Plan and Fiscal Year 2024 Action Plan, and to accept said grant funds.

This item is requesting the County's authorization to submit an application to the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) for grant funds in the approximate amount of \$5,809,844.33. For this continued discussion, the Legislators requested to have the consultant in attendance for inquiries that arose in the previous meeting.

A breakdown of the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) applicants was provided, including the years and amounts for which they were receiving funding for. CDBG does not have a required funding match from HUD, HOME Investment Partnership (HOME) has a 25% match from development activities and ESG has a dollar-for-dollar match from HUD. There were two surveys conducted, one for organizations (identifying what they think the community's needs are) and one for residents (identifying what are the community's needs). Participation was obtained either via a survey (available in English or Spanish), attending a public input session or providing feedback directly to the consultant, translation services were also available for further outreach. The County's Planning Department had an opportunity to vet the surveys as well as the Public Information Office. The ten goals to address affordable housing are: to improve and expand infrastructure; to improve access to public facilities; provide supportive public services; new housing development; rental housing opportunities; CHDO housing development; housing rehabilitation; homeless prevention and rapid rehousing and street outreach; emergency shelter and HMIS; and effective program management. The Planning Department continuously looks for surplus properties throughout the County in order to expand the housing stock and address affordable housing needs, since they cannot use CDBG funds for new housing.
