Westchester County has amended our Assigned Counsel Plan by enacting Chapter 186 of the Laws of Westchester County to establish an Independent Office of Assigned Counsel. 



Hon. Michelle I. Schauer is a Judge of the Westchester County Family Court. She is the Lead Judge for the Westchester County Court Improvement Project.

“I have had the privilege of working with the CASA program in Westchester County since 1999, when I was a Court Attorney Referee. I have had hundreds of cases with CASAs since then, so I can say with certainty that CASAs are an invaluable resource not only to the Court, but to all of the participants in the child welfare system. CASA’s thorough oversight, monitoring, and reporting is relied upon by all participants in the process and is oftentimes the impetus for positive - sometimes life-changing - differences in the lives of the children for whom they advocate. CASA enhances the ability of all of us in the child welfare system to work together towards the common goal of reversing the negative impact of child abuse and neglect and improving the lives of the children and families we serve. It is my privilege to partner with the CASA program and all of its extremely dedicated volunteers.”
