1. <u>ACT-2023-73</u> <u>ACT - Enter into Agreement with Sheppard Mullin re: Custom Marine, Inc.</u>

AN ACT authorizing the County of Westchester to retain, at County Expense, the law firm of Sheppard, Mullin, Richter & Hampton LLP, for the provision of outside counsel legal services in connection with a default by Custom Marine, Inc. under Department of Public Works & Transportation Contract No. 12-517-REV.

Mr. Sullivan said that Custom Marine misrepresented that they met the legal requirement that

20% of the subcontractors be Minority or Women Owned Business Enterprises (MWBEs). When the County discovered this, the County held them in default and gave them an opportunity to cure, but they have not satisfactorily shown they have met the requirement. Since the County will have to go to the surety to have the contract completed, the specialized knowledge of the attorneys at Sheppard Mullin will be particularly useful. Mr. Nonna added that due to the nature of the misreprentation, which includes falsified documents and business records, this has been referred to the District Attorney's Office and is being considered by the grand jury. He said the MWBE subcontractor was cooperating with the main contractor and getting paid to say they were the subcontractor, although they were not actually performing the work.
