An Act naming the baseball field located at Lower Scout Field, in Scout Field Park, "Bellitto Field".

BE IT ENACTED by the County Board of the County of Westchester as follows:

**Section 1.** The baseball field located at Lower Scout Field, in Scout Field Park, County of Westchester, State of New York, shall be and hereby is named Bellitto Field.

**Section 2.** This Act shall take effect immediately.
