

ACT NO. -2023

An Act approving Jeremy Basso as a member of the Westchester County Board of Ethics.

BE IT ENACTED by the County Board of the County of Westchester as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to Section 883.401 of the Laws of Westchester County, Jeremy Basso, has been appointed by the Chair of the Board of Legislators as a member of the Board of Ethics for a term to expire on December 31, 2023.

Section 2. The appointment of Jeremy Basso to the Board of Ethics is hereby approved for a term to expire on December 31, 2023.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect immediately.

Your Committee recommends passage of “An Act approving Jeremy Basso as a member of the Westchester County Board of Ethics.”


Your Committee is informed that pursuant to section 883.401 of the Laws of Westchester County, the Board of Ethics shall consist of seven members, five of whom shall be appointed by the County Executive, and two of whom shall be appointed by the Chair of the Board of Legislators. The members appointed by the County Executive shall be subject to confirmation by the Board of Legislators, while the members appointed by the Chair of the Board of Legislators shall be subject to approval by Act of the Board of Legislators.

Your Committee is further informed that Catherine Borgia, Chair of the Board of Legislators has appointed Jeremy Basso to serve as a member of the Board of Ethics for a term to expire on December 31, 2023. Mr. Basso has a long career working in the fields of finance and waste services, founding and operating an international waste services provider. Mr. Basso also works with his community, serving as a trustee of the Board of Education for the Hendrick Hudson School District as well as working with other civic organizations.

Your Committee therefore recommends approval of the appointment of Jeremy Basso as a member of the Board of Ethics.
