RESOLUTION

On motion of Trustee Alligood, seconded by Trustee Fleisig the following Resolution was duly adopted:

14:26 RESOLUTION PETITIONING THE U.S. GOVERNMENT TO END ICE AND CBP ABUSES

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that deployment of U.S. Immigration and Customs Enforcement (“ICE”) and U.S. Customs and Border Protection (“CBP”) agents in communities across the United States have resulted in tactics that have included excessive - and even deadly physical force; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that these tactics and practices by ICE and CBP have violated the constitutional rights of residents of our communities, and in some cases are abusive; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that these abusive tactics and practices by ICE and CBP are detrimental to appropriate and effective law enforcement and, contrary to best practices; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that these abusive tactics and practices by ICE and CBP are threatening the peace and welfare of our communities, and safety of residents and have resulted in the killing of residents; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Trustees believes that because of these abusive tactics and practices the continued deployment of ICE and CBP agents in our communities is threatening the lives, safety and civil rights of residents in such communities; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED: that in order to protect the lives of our residents and to safeguard the peace and welfare of our communities, we hereby petition the U.S. Government to protect our communities by taking the following steps:

- Conduct an independent investigation of tactics and practices employed by ICE and CBP;
- Adopt procedures to prevent abusive tactics and practices by ICE and CBP;
- Consider reform of immigration enforcement through the restructuring of the aforementioned enforcement agencies; and be it further

RESOLVED: that the Board of Trustees requests that our Federal, State and County elected officials consider the above steps and support action to have them adopted and implemented; and be it further

RESOLVED: that the Hastings-on-Hudson Police Department will follow its policy on Immigration Status including as it relates to interaction with Federal Immigration Authorities; and be it further


RESOLVED: that this resolution be forwarded to the President of the United States, the Speaker of the United States House of Representatives, the majority and minority leaders of the United States Senate and House of Representatives, the United States Senators representing the State of New York, the Representative of the 16th District in the United States House of Representatives, the Governor of the State of New York, the New York State Senator representing District 35, the New York State Assemblyperson representing District 92, the Westchester County Executive, and the County Legislator for District 12.
