#### 1. <u>2022-106</u> PH-Sewer District Mod-Removal-Harrison

Guests: DEF: Deputy Commissioner Nat Federici and Director of Maintenance Marian Pompa.

Mr. Pompa discussed the item He said that the Department of Health uses four criteria to evaluate requests for removal from the sewer district: 1) the property must be greater than 40,000 square feet in area, which is 0.92 acres; 2) the property must be greater than 100 feet from an available sanitary sewer connection; 3) the property must be a single family residence; and 4) the property must not have had a septic failure within the past five years. He

said that both properties at issue meet all the criteria. He said that neither the Department of Health nor the Department of Environmental Facilities objects to the removal.

Legislator Shimsky asked for clarification that the second criteria is 100 feet from the property line and not the residence, and Mr. Pompa confirmed that is correct. Legislator Barr asked if it is unusual for two parcels to be done at once. Mr. Pompa responded that he tries to group them together if possible, because it is less legislation for the BOL. He noted that they must be in the same sewer district in order to be grouped together.
