BOND ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$762,500 BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO FINANCE THE COST OF INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS ASSOCIATED WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF AFFORDABLE HOUSING UNITS ON PROPERTY LOCATED AT 81 ELLIOTT AVENUE, IN THE CITY OF YONKERS, IN ORDER TO AFFIRMATIVELY FURTHER FAIR HOUSING (“AFFH”) PURSUANT TO THE COUNTY’S HOUSING IMPLEMENTATION FUND II CAPITAL PROJECT; STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$762,500; STATING THE PLAN OF FINANCING SAID COST INCLUDES THE ISSUANCE OF \$762,500 BONDS HEREIN AUTHORIZED; AND PROVIDING FOR A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS (Adopted , 20__)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK (by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the voting strength of said Board), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (the “Law”), the Westchester County Administrative Code, being Chapter 852 of the Laws of 1948, as amended, and other laws applicable thereto, bonds of the County in the aggregate amount of \$762,500, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby authorized to be issued to finance the cost of infrastructure improvements associated with the construction of affordable housing units on property located at 81 Elliott Avenue, in the City of Yonkers, identified on tax maps as Section 1, Block 159, Lot 19 (the

“AFFH Property”) at a cost to the County of \$762,500, including related costs incurred by the County, which may include construction management and engineering costs, and staff and legal fees, in order to support the construction of affordable housing units that will affirmatively further fair housing (“AFFH”). The infrastructure improvements may include, but shall not be limited to, on-site and off-site paving, curbing, sidewalks, stormwater detention, drainage systems, sanitary sewer lines, water lines, lighting, signage, landscaping, construction management and County administrative costs. The funding requested herein, at the aggregate estimated maximum cost of \$762,500, is in support of the construction of 9 Affordable AFFH units. The County shall enter into an Inter-municipal/Developer Agreement (“IMDA”) with the City of Yonkers and 81 Elliott Avenue Housing Development Fund Company, Inc. (the “Developer”), its successors or assigns, to finance eligible infrastructure improvements associated with the construction of said affordable AFFH units (the “Development”). The County will file, or cause to be filed, a Declaration of Restrictive Covenants in the Westchester County Clerk’s office requiring that the housing units on the AFFH Property remain affordable for a period of not less than 50 years. The cost of said infrastructure improvements for the AFFH Property is set forth in the County’s Current Year Capital Budget, as amended. To the extent that the details set forth in this act are inconsistent with any details set forth in the Current Year Capital Budget of the County and the Statement of Need, such Budget and Statement of Need shall be deemed and are hereby amended. The estimated maximum cost of said object or purpose, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof, is \$762,500. The plan of financing includes the issuance of \$762,500 bonds herein authorized, and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds, and the levy and collection of a tax on taxable real property in the County to pay the

principal of and interest on said bonds and notes.

Section 2. The period of probable usefulness for which said \$762,500 bonds are authorized to be issued, within the limitations of Section 11.00 a. 91 of the Law, is fifteen (15) years.

Section 3. The County intends to finance, on an interim basis, the costs or a portion of the costs of said object or purpose for which bonds are herein authorized, which costs are reasonably expected to be reimbursed with the proceeds of debt to be incurred by the County, pursuant to this Bond Act, in the maximum amount of \$762,500. This Act is a declaration of official intent adopted pursuant to the requirements of Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.

Section 4. The estimate of \$762,500 as the estimated maximum cost of the aforesaid object or purpose is hereby approved.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of this Act and of the Law, and pursuant to the provisions of section 30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes and the renewals thereof, and of sections 50.00, 56.00 to 60.00 and 168.00 of said Law, the powers and duties of the County Board of Legislators relative to authorizing the issuance of any notes in anticipation of the sale of the bonds herein authorized, and the renewals thereof, relative to providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, relative to prescribing the terms, form and contents and as to the sale and issuance of the bonds herein authorized, and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds and the renewals of said notes, and relative to executing agreements for credit enhancement, are hereby delegated to the Commissioner of Finance of the County, as the chief fiscal officer of the County.

Section 6. Each of the bonds authorized by this Act and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale thereof shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by section 52.00 of said Local Finance Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall be general obligations of the County of Westchester, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the County. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds and the renewals of said notes, and provision shall be made annually in the budgets of the County by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the notes and bonds to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 7. The validity of the bonds authorized by this Act and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

(a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the County is not authorized to expend money, or

(b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of this Act or a summary hereof, are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

(c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 8. This Act shall take effect in accordance with Section 107.71 of the Westchester County Charter.

Complete copies of the Bond Act summarized herewith shall be available for public inspection during normal business hours at the Office of the Clerk of the Board of Legislators of the County of Westchester, New York, for a period of twenty days from the date of publication of this Notice.

Object or purpose: to finance the cost of infrastructure improvements associated with the construction of affordable housing units on property located at 81 Elliott Avenue, in the City of Yonkers, identified on tax maps as Section 1, Block 159, Lot 19 (the “AFFH Property”) at a cost to the County of \$762,500, including related costs incurred by the County, which may include construction management and engineering costs, and staff and legal fees, in order to support the construction of affordable housing units that will affirmatively further fair housing (“AFFH”).
