## BOARD OF LEGISLATORS COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER

Your Committee is in receipt of a proposed Act, which if enacted by your Board, would authorize the settlement of the County's potential liability in the lawsuit entitled, <u>Leonard Mack v. Westchester County</u>, et al, United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, Case No. 7:24-cv-08990-KMK, in the amount of \$341,250, inclusive of attorney's fees.

This matter is pending in the United States District Court for the Southern District of New York. The matter tentatively settled on June 27, 2025 pending this Board's approval of a settlement in the amount of \$341,250, inclusive of attorney's fees.

This matter arises out of a lawsuit that alleges, among other things, that Leonard Mack was arrested on May 22, 1975 for an attack on two teenaged girls, and thereafter was wrongfully convicted in connection with the attack and a rape of one girl, and as a result was subsequently incarcerated from May 1975 to December 1982. However, in 2022, as a result of DNA testing that did not exist in 1975, DNA testing established conclusively that Mack was not the rapist. A search of a law enforcement DNA database identified the actual perpetrator of the crime; that perpetrator has since admitted his responsibility for the crime and that he acted alone. Consequently, on September 5, 2023, a court granted a motion to vacate Mack's conviction and dismissed the indictment.

The settlement takes into consideration the uncertainty of litigation and the potential costs of trial, subsequent proceedings, and potential appeal, as well as the potential for any future claims against the County defendants by the Greenburgh defendants. Both outside counsel and our insurance companies recommend this settlement.

Your Committee has carefully considered the subject matter, the settlement proposal, the attached Act and recommends authorizing the County Attorney or his designee to settle the lawsuit entitled, <u>Leonard Mack v.</u>

<u>Westchester County, et al.</u>, United States District Court for the Southern District of New York, Case No. 7:24-cv-08990-KMK, in the amount of \$341,250, inclusive of attorney's fees.

An affirmative vote of a majority of the Board is required to pass this legislation.
