I. ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION

Guests: County Attorney John Nonna and Chief Deputy County Attorney Stacey Dolgin-Kmetz.

1. <u>2021-306</u> PH - Independent Office of Assigned Counsel

The committee members discussed changes to the law with Mr. Nonna and Ms. Dolgin-Kmetz. For Section 186.41(a), they requested that the words "Westchester County City Court Judge" be switched to the end of the second sentence for clarity. They also requested the removal of the language requiring that the member recommended by the Hudson Valley Hispanic Bar Association be a resident of Westchester County, and the addition of a sentence stating that "all attorney board members must practice or have practiced in Westchester County." They requested that the last sentence of the section be changed to read that "no member of the Board of Directors nor any current employee of Legal Aid" can serve on the Assigned Counsel Board.

Legislator Covil noted that Section 186.41 has 2 sections labeled (d), so the second section (d) and all subsequent sections through section (i) would need to be relettered accordingly.

For Section 186.81(d), they asked that the requirement for assigned counsel to have access to training programs should be through the County Bar Assocation "or" any other organizations instead of "and."

Ms. Dolgin-Kmetz agreed to make all of the requested changes to the legislation.

On motion of Legislator Covill, seconded by Committee Vice-Chair Shimsky, the above item was signed by committee. The motion carried unanimously.
