1. RES-2022-41 PH - A Local Law to Clarify the Retention of Outside Counsel

Guest: Deputy County Attorney Justin Adin

Deputy County Attorney Justin Adin said that the law states that no "board, body, commission or department of the county shall have or employ any attorney or counsel at the expense of the county unless specifically authorized to do so by the County Board." The phrase "at the expense of the county" could be interpreted to mean that county officers or employees could obtain pro bono legal services without seeking approval from the County Board, which would conflict with the first sentence of the provision which provides that the County Attorney shall be the legal advisor for the County. Mr. Adin said that to ensure a consistent interpretation of this section, the Law Department wants to remove "at the expense of the county."

Legislator Cunzio said the language referencing the County Attorney as "he" should be replaced with "he or she" to allow for a female County Attorney in the future. Legislator Shimsky said that replacing "he" with "County Attorney" would solve this problem. Mr. Adin said he would amend the legislation accordingly.
