A necessity exists for the enactment of this legislation because the local government does not have the power to enact such legislation by local law.

# The People of the State of New York, represented in Senate and Assembly, do enact as follows:

1 Section 1. Paragraph 1 of subdivision (a) of section 1111-g of the 2 vehicle and traffic law, as added by chapter 501 of the laws of 2023, is 3 amended to read as follows:

1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the county of Westches-4 5 ter is hereby authorized and empowered to adopt and amend a local law or ordinance establishing a demonstration program imposing monetary liabil-6 ity on the owner of a vehicle for failure of an operator thereof to 7 comply with traffic-control indications in such county in accordance 8 9 with the provisions of this section. Such demonstration program shall empower such county to install and operate traffic-control signal photo 10 violation-monitoring devices at no more than fifty intersections within 11 and under the jurisdiction of such county at any one time. Provided 12 that, in addition to the fifty intersections within and under its juris-13 14 diction, such county may install and operate traffic-control signal photo violation-monitoring devices at no more than one intersection 15 located on the portion of the Saw Mill River parkway within the village 16 of Pleasantville, county of Westchester, upon approval in writing 17 obtained by such county from the department of transportation, provided 18 19 that the department of transportation may at any time rescind or modify 20 such approval.

§ 2. The county of Westchester and commissioner of the New York state department of transportation are hereby authorized and empowered to install signage giving advance notice to motor vehicle operators of the

1 presence of traffic-control signal photo violation-monitoring devices 2 operated pursuant to a demonstration program authorized by article twen-3 ty-four of the vehicle and traffic law, in conformance with standards established in the manual on uniform traffic control devices maintained 4 5 by the commissioner of transportation pursuant to section sixteen hundred eighty of the vehicle and traffic law. Provided, however, that 6 7 the county of Westchester shall not place or maintain such signage on the Saw Mill River parkway unless or until approval in writing has been 8 obtained from the New York state department of transportation, and such 9 10 department of transportation may at any time rescind or modify such 11 approval. The county of Westchester is additionally authorized to 12 design and implement a public information campaign before traffic-control signal photo violation-monitoring devices authorized pursuant to 13 14 the provisions of paragraph one of subdivision (a) of section eleven 15 hundred eleven-g of the vehicle and traffic law, as amended by section 16 one of this act, go into operation, to notify and educate motor vehicle operators about such demonstration program. 17

18 § 3. This act shall take effect immediately; provided that the amend-19 ments to section 1111-g of the vehicle and traffic law made by section 20 one of this act shall not affect the repeal of such provision and shall 21 be deemed repealed therewith.
