Dear Members of the Board of Legislators:

Transmitted herewith for your review and approval is an Act which, if adopted, would authorize the County of Westchester ("County") to amend its current year Capital Budget (the "Capital Budget Amendment"), as well as adopt a related bond act ("Bond Act") in the amount of \$1,000,000, to finance the following capital project:

WCC94 - Yonkers Extension Center ("WCC94").

The proposed Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's current year capital budget to create an appropriation for this project in the amount of \$2,000,000. The related Bond Act, in the amount of \$1,000,000, would finance the County's approximately 50% share of the cost of voice and data equipment, cabling, and instructional equipment, as well as furniture, for the planned move and expansion of Westchester Community College's (the "College") Yonkers Extension Center. New York State has approved funding for the remaining 50% of the cost.

The College has advised that plans are underway for a physical move of the Yonkers Extension Center from 1 Mall Walk to space within the former Sears building of the Cross County Shopping Center. This move will more than double WCC's instructional and student support space, providing residents of Yonkers and the surrounding area expanded access to higher education and training, and offering employers in the city opportunities for customized training to meet their workforce needs. This project is required in order to make the expanded Yonkers Extension Center a state of the art instructional and training site. It will be equipped with the most up-to-date instructional technology available, recognizing the variety of new learning modalities that have been introduced in response to recent and current health and safety protocols. Smart classrooms and wireless labs are a few of the basic requirements. Distance learning labs as well as computer classrooms for ESL instruction will be needed. State of the Art audio visual equipment will be essential. Furniture will be needed in all regular classrooms, labs and the oversized lecture hall. Since the new building will also include offices for adjunct faculty, office furniture and equipment will be needed as well.

Following receipt by the College of State funds and bonding authorization from the County, the College anticipates that the work will be completed within approximately 18 months. It is anticipated that installation will be accomplished by in-house staff.

The Planning Department has advised that based on its review, the above-referenced capital project has been classified as a "Type II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617 ("SEQR"). Therefore, no further environmental review is required. As you know, your Honorable Board may use such expert advice to reach its own conclusion.

In addition, Section 167.131 of the County Charter mandates that a capital budget amendment that introduces a new capital project or changes the location, size or character of an existing capital project be accompanied to the Board of Legislators by a report of the Westchester County Planning Board (the "Planning Board") with respect to the physical planning aspects of the project. Accordingly, the Planning Board report is herewith attached.

Based on the importance of this project to the County, favorable action on the proposed Bond Act is respectfully requested.

#### HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmission from the County Executive recommending approval of an Act amending the County of Westchester's (the "County") current-year Capital Budget (the "Capital Budget Amendment"), as well as adoption of a related bond act (the "Bond Act") which, if approved, would authorize the County to issue \$1,000,000 in bonds to finance capital project WCC94 – Yonkers Extension Center ("WCC94").

Your Committee is advised that the proposed Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's current year capital budget to create an appropriation for this project in the amount of \$2,000,000. The related Bond Act, in the amount of \$1,000,000, which was prepared by the law firm of Harris Beach, would finance the County's approximately 50% share of the cost of voice and data equipment, cabling, and instructional equipment, as well as furniture, for the planned move and expansion of Westchester Community College's (the "College") Yonkers Extension Center. New York State has approved funding for the remaining 50% of the cost.

The College has advised your Committee that plans are underway for a physical move of the Yonkers Extension Center from 1 Mall Walk to space within the former Sears building of the Cross County Shopping Center. This move will more than double WCC's instructional and student support space, providing residents of Yonkers and the surrounding area expanded access to higher education and training, and offering employers in the city opportunities for customized training to meet their workforce needs. This project is required in order to make the expanded Yonkers Extension Center a state of the art instructional and training site. It will be equipped with the most up-to-date instructional technology available, recognizing the variety of new learning modalities that have been introduced in response to recent and current health and safety protocols. The Planning Department has advised your Committee that based on its review, the

above-referenced capital project has been classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State

Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617

("SEQR"). Therefore, no further environmental review is required. Your Committee has

reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this conclusion.

In addition, Section 167.131 of the County Charter mandates that a capital budget

amendment that introduces a new capital project or changes the location, size or character of an

existing capital project be accompanied to the Board of Legislators by a report of the Westchester

County Planning Board (the "Planning Board") with respect to the physical planning aspects of

the project. Accordingly, the required Planning Board report is attached hereto.

Your Committee is advised that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of this

Honorable Board is required in order to amend the County's Capital Budget, as well as to adopt

the related Bond Act.

Your Committee has carefully considered the proposed Capital Budget Amendment as

well as the related Bond Act, and recommends approval of both of the proposed Acts, noting that

the Bond Act can only be enacted following adoption of the Capital Budget Amendment.

#### JUSTIFICATION:

#### Planning Board Analysis:
