HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmission from the County Executive recommending approval by the County of Westchester ("County") of an act amending the County's current-year capital budget ("Capital Budget Amendment"), as well as adoption of a related bond act (the "Bond Act") which, if adopted, will authorize the County to issue an additional \$16,700,000 in bonds to finance capital project T0063 – New Bus Radio/Data System ("T0063").

Your Committee is advised that the Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's 2023 capital budget to increase the County share for this project by \$12,520,000 and reduce the non-County share by \$6,400,000.

The Department of Public Works and Transportation has advised that an RFP for this project was issued in January of 2023. Based upon the responses to the RFP, an updated cost estimate was developed. The funding requested in this Capital Budget Amendment represents the current cost estimate/needs for this project, noting that non-County funding, which was originally programmed for this project in 2020, will no longer be applied to this project.

The related Bond Act, prepared by the law firm of Harris Beach, PLLC, would provide \$16,700,000 in additional funding for a new comprehensive enterprise-wide technology communications system upgrade and associated costs for the fixed route Bee-Line bus system. Funding will be used to purchase and install software and hardware for the upgrade. It is anticipated that the software and hardware will be purchased and installation will begin during the second quarter of 2024.

Your Committee notes that your Honorable Board has previously authorized the County to issue bonds for T0063 as follows: Bond Act No. 99-2016 in the amount of \$300,000.00 which funded an evaluation of the voice and data communications needs of the Bee-Line system; and Bond Act No. 233-2019, which amended Bond Act No. 99-2016 by increasing the initial amount authorized by \$2,450,000.00, for a total authorized amount, as amended, of \$2,750,000.00, and which revised the scope of Bond Act No. 99-2016 to include costs related to the purchase of software and hardware. \$2,301,774 in bonds authorized by Bond Act No. 233-2019 have already

been sold. The current Bond Act will authorize an additional \$16,700,000 in bonds to purchase the software and hardware needed for this project, in accordance with the updated cost estimate.

The Planning Department has advised your Committee that based on its review, T0063 may be classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQR") and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617. Therefore, no environmental review is required. Your Committee has reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this recommendation.

The Planning Department has further advised your Committee that the Planning Board has previously reviewed T0063 and issued a report, and that since there is no change in the scope of the work and this is simply a change in the financing plan, no further action by the Planning Board is necessary at this time.

Your Committee has carefully considered the proposed Capital Budget Amendment, as well as the related Bond Act, and recommends approval of both of the proposed Acts, noting that the Bond Act can only be enacted following adoption of the Capital Budget Amendment. It should be noted that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of your Honorable Board is required in order to amend the County's Capital Budget and to adopt the Bond Act.

The County Executive is requesting an amendment to the 2023 Capital Budget to modify the funding of the above project. Capital project **T0063 New Bus Radio and Data**Systems (2023 CBA) will fund the evaluation and procurement of a new comprehensive enterprise-wide technology communications system upgrade for the fixed route Bee-Line bus system. The capital budget amendment will fund increased costs in Phase 1 of 2.

The Capital Budget Amendment (CBA) adds \$6.12 million to the project and removes the non-county share \$6.4 million from the project financing plan. The revised appropriation if the capital budget amendment is adopted will be \$19.45 million. This project was classified as a PL1, a project with no physical planning aspects by the Planning Board in the 2020 Report on the Capital Project Requests adopted July 2, 2019.

There are no changes to the physical planning aspects of this project as reviewed by the Board; therefore, no further action by your Board is necessary.
