### **Pride Flag Raising**

March 2021- June 2021

- Contacted Rye City council members about raising a pride flag on city property for the first time ever.
- Attended city council meetings to speak about the issue, organized talking points among peers, and consulted with national LGBTQ+ rights organizations as well as members of local government.





I have spent my entire career helping medical practices maximize revenue and streamline operations. 




