

RESOLUTION 17 - 2026

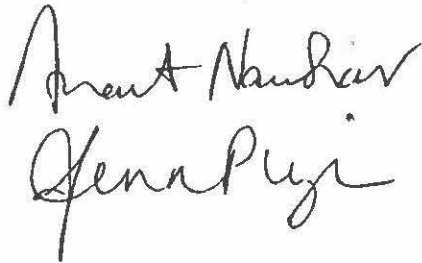
TO THE COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS

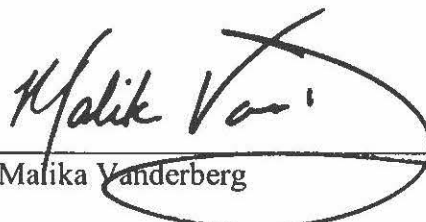
