# HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmittal from the County Executive recommending approval by the County of Westchester ("County") of an act, which, if adopted, will amend the County's current-year capital budget ("Capital Budget Amendment"), as well as adoption of a related bond act ("Bond Act") in the amount of \$15,895,000 prepared by the law firm Norton Rose Fulbright to finance capital project SPK20 – Forcemain Rehabilitation – Peekskill Sewer District ("SPK20").

Your Committee is advised that the proposed Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's current-year capital budget to increase the appropriation for SPK20 by \$4,300,000. The capital budget amendment is necessary to due to cost escalation.

Your Committee is further advised by the Department of Environmental Facilities ("Department") that the Bond Act, in the amount of \$15,895,000, would finance the cost of design, construction management and construction costs for the rehabilitation or replacement of force mains and gravity sewers in the Peekskill Sanitary Sewer District, including rehabilitation and replacement of sections of the Water Street Force Main, construction or reconstruction of sewer pipes and manholes and incidental expenses.

The Department has advised that the construction of SPK20 is expected to be undertaken simultaneously with the rehabilitation of the Water Street Pumping Station in the Peekskill Sanitary Sewer District which will be undertaken in accordance with Capital Project SPK95.

Design is currently being undertaken by a consultant and is expected to be completed by the end of the third quarter of 2024. It is estimated that construction will take fifteen months to complete and will begin after award and execution of the construction contracts.

It should be noted that your Honorable Board has previously authorized the County to issue bonds in connection with SPK20 as indicated in the annexed fact sheet.

The Planning Department has advised your Committee that based on its review, SPK20 may be classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQR") and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617. Therefore, no environmental review is required. Your Committee has reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this recommendation.

The Planning Department has advised your Committee that the Planning Board has previously reviewed SPK20 and issued a report, and that since there is no change in the scope of the work and this is simply a change in the financing plan, no further action by the Planning Board is necessary at this time.

Your Committee has carefully considered the proposed Capital Budget Amendment, as well as the related Bond Act, and recommends approval of both of the proposed Acts, noting that the Bond Act may only be enacted following adoption of the Capital Budget Amendment. It should also be noted that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of your Honorable Board is required in order to amend the County's Capital Budget and to adopt the Bond Act.

**PROJECT/ACTION:** Per Capital Project Fact Sheet as approved by the Planning Department on

06-18-2024 (Unique ID: 2559)

With respect to the State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations 6 NYCRR Part 617, the Planning Department recommends that no environmental review is required for the proposed action, because the project or component of the project for which funding is requested may be classified as a **TYPE II action** pursuant to section(s):

- 617.5(c)(2): replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building, energy, or fire codes unless such action meets or exceeds any of the thresholds in section 617.4 of this Part;
- 617.5(c)(6): street openings and right-of-way openings for the purpose of repair or maintenance of existing utility facilities.

**COMMENTS:** The majority of the rehabilitation work involves lining of the existing pipes. A portion of the pipelines, which run within a narrow space between active railroad tracks and several industrial buildings, will be replaced by extending the pipes already within the North Water Street right-of-way further north before connecting to the existing pipelines running alongside the railroad tracks. The street, which curves towards the railroad tracks a little further north, provides a better location for the installation and maintenance of the sewer lines with less environmental impacts.

This project is being combined with capital project SPK95, which provides for the rehabilitation of the Water Street Pumping Station, which may also be classified as a Type II action. The combined actions would not exceed any of the thresholds that would disqualify them from the Type II classification.

Peekskill Sewer District (2024 CBA)

The County Executive is requesting an amendment to the 2024 Capital Budget to modify the funding of the above project. Capital project **SPK20 Forcemain Rehabilitation Peekskill Sewer District** will fund construction and construction management for the rehabilitation and replacement of sections of the Water Street Force Main in the Peekskill Sanitary Sewer District.

The capital budget amendment is needed because of the increased costs associated with this project. The total requested amount of \$17,600,000 includes \$13,300,000 of previously appropriated funds and a new CBA request of \$4,300,000. This project was classified as a PL2 in the 2005 Planning Board Report on Capital Project Requests adopted July 13, 2004.

There are no changes to the physical planning aspects of this project as reviewed by the Board; therefore, no further action by your Board is necessary.
