Ms. Käufer presented on the initiatives provided by The STEM Alliance to address the digital divide in the County of Westchester. One of the limitations that people experience is the inability to access or afford devices. Additionally, they are ill informed on how to use them in general. After providing an overview on their data collected within the past year, Ms. Käufer explained that that they conduct follow up with those who were helped in order to get an idea of the amount of improvement. Access to digital devices also allow for Asset Limited, Constrained, Employed (ALICE) households to obtain devices, connectivity and/or proper education on how to use these systems. In many cases, trainings on using the software programs available, such as Google Suite, can open an array of possibilities for many individuals.
