PROJECTS

Pride Flag Raising

March 2021- June 2021

- Contacted Rye City council members about raising a pride flag on city property for the first time ever.
- Attended city council meetings to speak about the issue, organized talking points among peers, and consulted with national LGBTQ+ rights organizations as well as members of local government.
- Asked for the support of citizens and community leaders.
- Participated in several interviews for local and regional news outlets.
- Spoke at ceremonies where the pride flag was being raised for the first time in several locations; my high school, at city hall, and at the town park, and was an invited guest at the county flag raising and mural unveiling.

Food Waste Reduction Pledge, School Project

May 2021- June 2021

- Worked in a group of five to gather quantitative data on food waste at local businesses and come up with a pledge for businesses to sign to reduce food waste.
- Researched composting and waste reduction practices, presented findings at a Chamber of Commerce meeting, and spoke individually to local businesses.
- Met our goal of 5 businesses by a certain date.

Food Drive, School Project

December 2020

- Helped run a two week food drive at one of the elementary schools in the district.
- Communicated with school administrators, helped design posters,

and picked up donations.

Save the Pollinators, School Project

October 2020- December 2020

- Partnered with the Rye Nature Center to develop a lesson plan about bees, pollinators, and local plants for 7-11 year olds
- Helped plan a group discussion, a craft, and tour of the pollinator gardens.
