1. <u>RES-2023-113</u> <u>PH - Amendment to Clinic Access Law</u>

Mr. Adin said that this amendment removes the bubble zone provision which prohibits people from approaching others within eight feet for the purposes of engaging in protest education and counseling. It also removes the definitions referencing that provision. Ms. LaMagna added that since passing this law they have not seen the bubble zone provision to be beneficial. She noted that removing this provision makes the law more clear and direct in knowing where the protections start and stop. Mr. Adin stated that to his understanding, there are no proceedings where someone has been charged with a violation under this provision at this time.
