

Dr. Wu is an Emeritus Researcher at IBM Research. A Trustee of the New School in NYC and the KECK Graduate Institute for Applied Life Sciences (a Claremont college). She was for many years a Trustee of Fordham University.

Dr. Wu is a board member of the EcoHealth Alliance, the Muscular Dystrophy Association and Public Agenda in NYC. She is a council member of the Burke Neurological Institute (Weill Cornell Medicine). She was a member of Tufts Medical Center's Quality of Care Committee and Tufts' Patient Family Advisory Committee.

In IBM Research she co-founded the IBM East & South-east Asian Scientists & Technologists Business Resource Group and is a member of their Executive Committee. Her recent publications on careers of Asians: Leadership Hurdles, Asian researchers and engineers are too rarely made US science leaders.
