LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION


WHEREAS, on September 29, 2023, a severe storm created hazardous conditions in the County of Westchester, posing an imminent danger to public transportation, utility service, public health, and public safety systems; and

WHEREAS, the storm produced torrential downpours, high winds, and flash flooding, which has or may cause downed trees, road closures, travel disruptions, power outages, and damage to public and private property in these areas of county, which pose a threat to the public health and safety; and

WHEREAS, on September 29, 2023, I, George S. Latimer, County Executive of the County of Westchester, and Chief Executive Officer of the County of Westchester, do hereby exercise my authority pursuant to Article 2-B of the New York State Executive Law to preserve and protect the public health and safety in response to the storm and declared a Local State of Emergency; and

WHEREAS, the severe weather has abated, and the need for the Local State of Emergency has ended;

NOW THEREFORE, I hereby rescind the Local State of Emergency Declaration issued on September 29, 2023.
