Discussion on the Yonkers Waste Water Treatment Plant

Guests: Department of Environmental Facilities

Commissioner Vincent Kopicki

Commissioner Kopicki spoke about ongoing projects at the wastewater treatment plant, with a focus on improving efficiency, controlling odors, and strengthening communication with the community. Among the project overviews provided were the odor control project (which is expected to be completed in 12 to 18 months) and upgrades such as engine replacements, bulkhead repairs, and electrical improvements, among other projects. While these efforts are expected to reduce odors and complaints, there was mention of the need for better communication and responsiveness to residents' concerns. There was a shared commitment

to improving transparency, providing regular updates and enhancing public education on waste management.
