#### **CALL TO ORDER**

## 1. ACT-2021-112 BOND ACT-RKL01-Tarrytown Lighthouse Restoration

A BOND ACT authorizing the issuance of THREE MILLION, THREE HUNDRED ELEVEN THOUSAND (\$3,311,000) DOLLARS in bonds of Westchester County to finance Capital Project RKL01 - Tarrytown Lighthouse Restoration.

Submitted by COMMITTEES ON BUDGET & APPROPRIATIONS, PUBLIC WORKS & TRANSPORTATION AND PARKS & RECREATION

Joint with B&A and P&R.

First Deputy Commissioner Tartaglia appeared before the joint committees to discuss capital project RKL01- Tarrytown Lighthouse Restoration. This is a Bond Act in the amount of \$3,311,000 to finance the restoration and rehabilitation of the County-owned Tarrytown Lighthouse. This project will stabilize the structure and prevent further deterioration. Work will consist of repairs and repainting to the exterior cast iron, replacement of windows and doors, repair of crack in the cellar/caisson area, cleaning, cleaning and re-pointing of the foundation masonry, restoration of the interior plaster and painting finishes throughout, and repairs to and restoration of all the wood floors. Work will also include reconstruction of the intermediate landing between the bridge and gangway, a new security gate on the mainland, and new electric and exterior lighting. The Tarrytown Lighthouse, located just off the Kingsland Point Park shoreline, is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. Mr. Tartaglia discussed that the Lighthouse dates back to 1883, they started the design on this project in 2011 and there is obviously more deterioration from the Hudson River. He discussed that there are not many of these Lighthouse left. They are called sparkplug lighthouses and date back to the 1800's.

On motion of Committee Vice-Chair Shimsky, seconded by Legislator Covill, the above item was signed by committee. The motion carried by the following vote:
