BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT COLLINS-BELLAMY, MAJORITY LEADER RUBBO, MAJORITY WHIP ROBINSON, MINORITY LEADER BREEN, COUNCILMEMBERS, PINEDA –ISAAC, DIAZ AND MERANTE:

A RESOLUTION ASSUMING LEAD AGENCY STATUS, DETERMINING THAT THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT CONSTITUTES AN UNLISTED ACTION, ADOPTING A NEGATIVE DECLARATION PURSUANT TO THE NEW YORK STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW ACT WITH RESPECT TO THE PROPOSED AMENDMENT OF THE ZONING ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF YONKERS IN REGARD TO IN REGARD TO THE CLEAR CUTTING AND EXCAVATION OF LAND PRIOR TO REQUIRED SITE PLAN APPROVAL, AND SETTING A DATE AND TIME FOR THE CONDUCT OF A PUBLIC HEARING WITH RESPECT TO SUCH PROPOSED AMENDMENT.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 43-162 of the Zoning Ordinance of the City of Yonkers (the "Zoning Ordinance"), and at the written request of the City of Yonkers Planning Board (the "City Planning Board"), dated November 20, 2023 (the "City Planning Board Request"), the City Council proposes to enact a general ordinance (the "Proposed Official Action") to amend Chapter 43 of the Code of the City of Yonkers entitled "Zoning" in regard to concerns related to clear cutting and excavation of land prior to site plan approval, to eliminate the several problems accruing from this practice; and

WHEREAS, by resolution duly adopted by the City Council on March 12, 2024, the City Council adopted and circulated a resolution to declare its intent to act as Lead Agency in accordance with the provisions of 6 NYCRR Part 617 of the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act (Environmental Control Act §8-0101 et seq.) ("SEQRA"), in order to initiate a review process of the Proposed Official Action; and

WHEREAS, the Proposed Official Action, together with the City Council's declaration of its intent to establish its Lead Agency status, was thereupon referred by the City Council pursuant to SEQRA, Section 239-m of the General Municipal Law of the State of New York and Section 43-164 of the Zoning Ordinance, respectively, to the City Planning Board and the Westchester County Planning Board (the "County Planning Board") for their respective review and recommendation; and

WHEREAS, more than thirty (30) days have passed since the date such referrals were made by the City Council to the City Planning Board and the County Planning Board, respectively, and the City Council has received no objection to the City Council acting as Lead Agency for purposes of the review of the Proposed Official Action or to the Proposed Official Action itself; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, as Lead Agency, has reviewed and considered the entire record, including Parts 1, 2 and 3 of the EAF and the City Planning Board Request, together with the criteria set forth in §617.7(c) of the SEQRA regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has identified and carefully considered the relevant areas of environmental concern to determine whether the Proposed Official Action will result in any significant adverse environmental impacts in light of the criteria set forth in §617.7(c) of the SEQRA regulations; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to conduct a public hearing on the Proposed Official Action in accordance with the requirements of Section 43-165 of the Zoning Ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT, the City Council hereby assumes the Lead Agency status for the review of the Proposed Official Action pursuant to and in furtherance of SEQRA requirements; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, the City Council hereby determines that the Proposed Official Action constitutes an "Unlisted Action" under SEQRA and has completed, or caused to have completed, a short form environmental assessment form (the "EAF") with respect thereto; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, based upon the City Council's review of the entire record, including the EAF, and for the reasons set forth therein, the City Council hereby adopts a Negative Declaration under SEQRA that the Proposed Official Action will not result in any significant adverse impact on the environment, and that the preparation of an Environmental Impact Statement is not required; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED that on June 26, 2024 at 6:15 p.m., the City Council shall conduct a public hearing on the Proposed Official Action in accordance with the requirements of Section 43-165 of the Zoning Ordinance and notice thereof shall be given in accordance with Section 43-165; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, a copy of this resolution be filed in the Office of the City Clerk and be furnished to the City Planning Board, the County Planning Board and those requesting a copy; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, this resolution, or notice of the adoption thereof, be published in the Environmental Notice Bulletin of the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED THAT, this resolution shall take effect immediately.
