1. RES-2023-54 PH - For-Hire Vehicle Law Amendment

Guests: Law Dept.: Loren Zeitler, Senior Assistant County Attorney and Stacey Dolgin-Kmetz, Chief Deputy County Attorney; Taxi & Limousine Commission: Leandra Eustache, Chairperson

Ms. Dolgin-Kmetz said that the law provides that drivers, owners and base station owners of vehicles receive notice of violations before a vehicle is booted. The problem is that the base station may have many drivers, and drivers of vehicles associated with the base station have been booted or towed when they have not personally violated the law, but the base station has. They are eliminating notification to the base station because it is unfair to the drivers. She noted that the County is currently in litigation with regard to this section of the law, and suggested they discuss the pending litigation in executive session.

With a motion by Legislator Barr seconded by Legislator Woodson-Samuels, the committee went into executive session at 1:25 p.m. to discuss pending litigation. With a motion by Legislator Woodson- Samuels seconded by Legislator Barr, the committee came out of executive session at 1:41 p.m.
