MINUTES APPROVAL

On motion of Legislator Smith, seconded by Legislator Barr, the minutes were approved. The motion carried unanimously.

1. RES-2021-124 Authorizing Mandatory Referendum Publication - Ethics Law Amendment

Sunday Vanderberg, Clerk and Chief Administrative Officer of the Board of Legislators, advised that the public must be given notice that this will be on the ballot at the general election on November 2nd. The notice will run every Sunday from September 26th through October 31st in the newspaper and online. Legislator Covill noted that we must provide notice because although there will still be seven members of the Board of Ethics, two will now be appointed by the Board of Legislators, and the County Charter mandates that a transfer of power from the County Executive to the Board of Legislators must be approved by County residents by a majority vote.

On motion of Legislator Barr, seconded by Legislator Shimsky, the above item was signed by committee.

2. <u>2021-306</u> PH - Independent Office of Assigned Counsel

Mr. Soule discussed the budgetary implications of the legislation. He said the goal is to make

this budget neutral. Legislator Barr asked if our personnel costs will be higher than Legal Aid because they are not unionized. Mr. Soule said our salaries will be higher than what they are paying for equivalent positions due to fringe benefits. Legislator Covill asked what this looks like vis-à-vis our current contract with Legal Aid. Mr. Soule and Mr. Nonna suggested going into executive session to discuss contract negotiations with Legal Aid.

With a motion by Legislator Covill seconded by Legislator Smith, the committee went into executive session at 1:41 p.m. With a motion by Legislator Covill seconded by Legislator Smith, the committee came out of executive session at 1:56 p.m.
