#### APPT-Council for Seniors-Miller

*Committee Chairwoman Parker expressed that she was highly impressed by Ms. Miller's professional résumé, noting her strong and unique background in finance. Chairwoman Parker inquired whether Ms. Miller intended to bring that financial expertise to the Council for Seniors, especially in light of the increasing prevalence of financial scams targeting senior citizens.*

*In response, Ms. Miller emphasized that Article 81, which addresses guardianship for incapacitated adults, is a subject of great importance to her. She affirmed her commitment to contributing meaningfully to the council and supporting its efforts in any capacity possible. Majority Leader Tyrae Woodson-Samuels also commended Ms. Miller's credentials, highlighting her qualifications and expressing appreciation for her experience. He raised concerns about housing challenges frequently faced by senior citizens and stressed the need for focused advocacy in this area. Ms. Miller responded by stating that she has access to valuable resources and professional contacts that could aid in addressing such issues. Chairman Vedat Gashi concluded by thanking Ms. Miller for her dedication, her willingness to serve, and the expertise she brings to the council.*
