

(BOND) ACT 266 - 2025

**HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS
THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK**

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmittal from the County Executive recommending approval by the County of Westchester ("County") of a bond act ("Bond Act") in the amount of \$750,000 to finance capital project CC109 Hartford Hall HVAC Replacement ("CC109"). The Bond Act, which was prepared by the law firm Harris Beach, will finance the County's approximately 50% share of cost of Hartford Hall heating, ventilation and air conditioning ("HVAC") improvements at the Westchester Community College ("College") including the design and construction of the full system replacement of the Harford Hall ductless split air conditioning systems, and the reconfiguring and replacement of the related piping and insulation, and air conditioning controls. The purpose of this project is to make the mechanical repairs and upgrades.

The College has advised that the existing HVAC system has reached its expected lifespan.

The College has advised that the total amount appropriated for CC109 is \$1,500,000. This bond request in the amount of \$750,000 represents the County's approximately 50% share of CC109. The remaining 50% will be funded by New York State.

Following bonding authorization, design will be scheduled and is anticipated to take twelve months to complete. It is anticipated that the design work will be completed by a consultant. It is estimated that construction will take eighteen months to complete and will begin after award and execution of construction contracts.

The Planning Department has advised your Committee that based on its review, CC109 may be classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQR") and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617. Therefore, no environmental review is required. Your Committee has reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this recommendation.

It should be noted that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of your Honorable Board is required in order to adopt the Bond Act. Your Committee recommends the adoption of the proposed Bond Act.






- **617.5(c)(2):** replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building, energy, or fire codes unless such action meets or exceeds any of the thresholds in section 617.4 of this Part.

COMMENTS: The building is on the National Register of Historic Places. It is anticipated that all repairs and improvement will be consistent with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties.

ACT NO. 266 -2025

BOND ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$750,000 BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO FINANCE THE COST OF HARTFORD HALL HVAC IMPROVEMENTS AT THE WESTCHESTER COMMUNITY COLLEGE; STATING THE TOTAL ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$1,500,000; STATING THE PLAN OF FINANCING SAID COST INCLUDES THE ISSUANCE OF \$750,000 BONDS HEREIN AUTHORIZED TO FINANCE THE COUNTY'S SHARE OF SUCH COST AND THE APPLICATION OF \$750,000 EXPECTED TO BE RECEIVED FROM THE STATE OF NEW YORK TOWARDS THE COST OF SAID OBJECTS OR PURPOSES; AND PROVIDING FOR A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS. (Adopted 12/08 , 2025)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK (by the affirmative vote of not less than Third-thirds of the voting strength of said Board), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (the "Law"), the Westchester County Administrative Code, being Chapter 852 of the Laws of 1948, as amended, to the provisions of other laws applicable thereto, \$750,000 bonds of the County, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby authorized to be issued to finance the cost of Hartford Hall HVAC improvements at the Westchester Community College; including the design and construction of the full system replacement of the Harford Hall ductless split air conditioning systems, and the

reconfiguring and replacement of the related piping and insulation, and air conditioning controls. The purpose of this project is to make the mechanical repairs and upgrades all as set forth in the County's current year Capital Budget, as amended. To the extent that the details set forth in this act are inconsistent with any details set forth in the current year Capital Budget of the County, such Budget shall be deemed and is hereby amended. The estimated maximum cost of said object or purpose, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof is \$1,500,000. The plan of financing includes the issuance of \$750,000 bonds herein authorized and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds, the application of \$750,000 expected to be received from the State of New York to be expended towards the cost of said objects or purposes, and the levy of a tax to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds and notes.

Section 2. The period of probable usefulness applicable to the specific object or purpose for which the bonds authorized by this resolution is to be issued, within the limitations of Section 11.00 a. 13 of the Law, is ten (10) years.

Section 3. Current funds are not required to be provided as a down payment pursuant to Section 107.00 d. 9. of the Law prior to issuance of the bonds authorized herein, or any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds. The County intends to finance, on an interim basis, the costs or a portion of the costs of said improvements for which bonds are herein authorized, which costs are reasonably expected to be reimbursed with the proceeds of debt to be incurred by the County, pursuant to this Act, in the maximum amount of \$750,000. This Act is a declaration of official intent adopted pursuant to the requirements of Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.

Section 4. Subject to the provisions of this Act and of the Law, and pursuant to the provisions of §30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes or the renewals thereof, and of §§50.00, 56.00 to 60.00 and 168.00 of said Law, the powers and duties of the County Board of Legislators relative to authorizing the issuance of any notes in anticipation of the sale of the bonds herein authorized, or the renewals thereof, relative to providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, relative to prescribing the terms, form and contents and as to the sale and issuance of the respective amounts of bonds herein authorized, and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds or the renewals of said notes, and relative to executing agreements for credit enhancement, are hereby delegated to the Commissioner of Finance of the County, as the chief fiscal officer of the County.

Section 5. Each of the bonds authorized by this Act and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale thereof shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by §52.00 of said Local Finance Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall be general obligations of the County of Westchester, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the County. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds or the renewals of said notes, and provision shall be made annually in the budgets of the County by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the notes and bonds to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 6. The validity of the bonds authorized by this Act and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

(a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the County is not authorized to expend money, or

(b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of this Act or a summary hereof, are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

(c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 7. This Act shall take effect in accordance with Section 107.71 of the Westchester County Charter.

A study of the Hartford Hall ductless splits systems determined that the existing HVAC system has reached its useful lifespan and a full replacement system is necessary.

Current Bond Description: Current bonding approval is necessary to fund the County's 50% share of this new project. This project totals \$1,500,000 for the design and construction of the full system replacement of the Harford Hall ductless split air conditioning systems and reconfigure and replace the related piping and insulation throughout the building. Existing piping and insulation will be salvaged and reused where possible. The air conditioning controls will be updated to connect to the campus Andover building management system to allow for remote monitoring and controls. The purpose of this project is to make the mechanical repairs and upgrades necessary to preserve this historic building.


