# HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmittal from the County Executive recommending approval of an act, which, if adopted, will authorize the County of Westchester ("County") to amend the County's current-year capital budget ("Capital Budget Amendment"), as well as adopt a related amended bond act (the "Amended Bond Act") in the total amount of \$5,125,000, which includes \$3,775,000 in previously authorized bonds of the County, to finance capital project RB031 – Tuckahoe Road Bridge Over Bronx River, Yonkers and Tuckahoe (BIN 3364940) ("RB031").

Your Committee is advised that the Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's current-year capital budget to increase the County share for RB03I by \$1,350,000. The Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") has advised that the bids received for the construction contract exceeded the available funding for the project. There have been significant material cost increases across the construction industry due to current global and national economic conditions. The market volatility has resulted in unknown material costs day-to-day and thus, asphalt and steel suppliers are increasing prices to account for the ever-changing prices. On a regional level, there is a shortage of ready-mix concrete suppliers in Westchester County, which has led to less competitive bidding and increased material costs for concrete items. Therefore, \$1,350,000 in additional appropriations are needed to award the construction contract.

Your Committee is further advised that the Amended Bond Act, prepared by the law firm of Hawkins, Delafield & Wood LLP, would finance additional construction management and construction costs associated with the rehabilitation of the Tuckahoe Road bridge over the Bronx River. The work includes the complete removal and replacement of the pavement, fill, sidewalks and waterproofing membrane, the removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete on the structure, address erosion and scour problems with riprap and bioremediation along the banks and stone facing repair and repoint work, as well as additional work and coordination to shut down power and expose, support and protect a high-voltage line (NYPA) on the bridge during construction.

The Department has advised that this bridge, which has an annual daily traffic count ("AADT") of 7,340, is in need of rehabilitation to maintain a safe roadway for the travelling

public. In 2025 the New York State Department of Transportation gave the bridge a condition rating of 4.22 and the bridge has continued to deteriorate. This rating system, using a scale of 1 ("hazardous") through 7 ("new"), is a weighted average of the conditions of an evaluated bridge. A rating below 5 indicates that a bridge requires work and delay of this work could result in the continued deterioration of the bridge.

Your Committee is advised that design has been completed for this project by an outside consultant. Construction is estimated to take eighteen (18) months and shall begin after award and execution of the construction contracts.

It should be noted that your Honorable Board has previously authorized the County to issue bonds for RB03I as follows: Bond Act No. 43-2015 in the amount of \$280,000 which financed the design portion of this project, as amended and restated by Bond Act No. 216-2024 in the total amount of \$3,775,000, to finance the cost of construction and construction management associated with this project. No bonds have been issued under the previous bond acts. Accordingly, authority is now requested to amend Bond Act No. 216-2024 to increase the amount authorized thereunder by \$1,350,000, for a total authorized amount, as amended, of \$5,125,000.00, to include additional construction and construction management costs necessary to complete this project.

The Department of Planning has advised your Committee that based on its review, the authorization of the proposed referenced capital project may be classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617 ("SEQR"). Therefore, no environmental review is required. Your Committee has reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this recommendation.

The Planning Department has further advised your Committee that the Planning Board has previously reviewed this project and issued a report, and that since there is no change in the scope of the work but simply a change in the financing plan, no further action by the Planning Board is necessary at this time.

Your Committee has carefully considered the proposed Capital Budget Amendment, as well as the related Amended Bond Act, and recommends approval of both proposed Acts, noting that the Amended Bond Act may only be enacted following adoption of the Capital Budget Amendment. It

should also be noted that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of your Honorable Board is required in order to amend the County's Capital Budget and to adopt the Amended Bond Act.



#### ACT NO. 248 - 2025

BOND ACT OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK, AMENDING THE BOND ACT ADOPTED MARCH 23, 2015 AND HERETOFORE AMENDED ON OCTOBER 21, 2024 IN RELATION TO THE REHABILITATION OF THE TUCKAHOE ROAD BRIDGE OVER THE BRONX RIVER, AT THE MAXIMUM ESTIMATED COST OF \$5,125,000 (Adopted 11/17, 2025).

WHEREAS, this Board has heretofore duly authorized the issuance of \$280,000 bonds to finance the cost of preparation of surveys, preliminary and detailed plans, specifications and estimates necessary for the rehabilitation of the Tuckahoe Road Bridge, pursuant to Act No. 43-2015 duly adopted on March 23, 2015; and

WHEREAS, this Board has heretofore amended Act No. 43-2015 to authorize such improvements and to increase the amount of bonds authorized for such scope of work to \$3,775,000, pursuant to Act No. 216-2024 duly adopted on October 21, 2024;

WHEREAS, it has been determined that additional funds are required for to pay for the cost of the Project, and it is necessary to increase the amount of bonds to be issued and the appropriation for such project for estimated cost of such scope of work, now therefore

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK (by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the voting strength of said Board), AS FOLLOWS:

Section (A). The bond act duly adopted by this Board on March 23, 2015 and amended on October 21, 2024, entitled:

"ACT NO. 216-2024

BOND ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,775,000 BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO FINANCE THE REHABILITATION OF THE TUCKAHOE ROAD BRIDGE OVER THE BRONX RIVER, STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$3,775,000; STATING THE PLAN OF FINANCING SAID COST INCLUDES THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,775,000 BONDS HEREIN AUTHORIZED; AND PROVIDING FOR A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS."

is hereby amended to read as follows:

BOND ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$5,125,000 BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO FINANCE THE REHABILITATION OF THE TUCKAHOE ROAD BRIDGE OVER THE BRONX RIVER, STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$5,125,000; STATING THE PLAN OF FINANCING SAID COST INCLUDES THE ISSUANCE OF \$5,125,000 BONDS HEREIN AUTHORIZED; AND PROVIDING FOR A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS. (Adopted 11/17, 2025)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK (by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the voting strength of said Board), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (the "Law"), the Westchester County Administrative Code, being Chapter 852 of the Laws of 1948, as amended, and to the provisions of other laws applicable thereto; \$5,125,000 bonds of the County, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby authorized to be issued to finance the planning, construction and construction management in connection with the rehabilitation of the Tuckahoe Road Bridge over the Bronx River, including the removal and replacement of pavement, fill, sidewalks, and waterproofing membrane and related work, removal and replacement of deteriorated concrete on the structure, addressing of erosion and scour problems with rip-rap and bioremediation along the banks, repair and repoint of stone facing, and additional work and coordination to shut down power, expose, support, and protect the NYPA high voltage line on the bridge during construction, all as set forth in the County's Current Year Capital Budget, as amended. To the extent that the details set forth in this act are inconsistent with any details set forth in the Current Year Capital Budget of the County, such Budget shall be deemed and is hereby amended. The estimated maximum cost of said specific object or purpose, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the financing thereof is \$5,125,000. The plan of financing includes the issuance of \$5,125,000 bonds herein authorized; and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds and the levy of a tax to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds and notes.

Section 2. The period of probable usefulness of the specific object or purpose for which said \$5,125,000 bonds authorized by this Act are to be issued, within the limitations of Section 11.00 a. 10 of the Law, is forty (40) years;

Section 3. Current funds are not required to be provided as a down payment pursuant to Section 107.00 d. 9. of the Law prior to issuance of the bonds authorized herein, or any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds. The County intends to finance, on an interim basis, the costs or a portion of the costs of said improvements for which bonds are herein authorized, which costs are reasonably expected to be reimbursed with the proceeds of debt to be incurred by the County, pursuant to this Act, in the maximum amount of \$5,125,000. This Act is a declaration of official intent adopted pursuant to the requirements of Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.

Section 4. The estimate of \$5,125,000 as the estimated maximum cost of the aforesaid specific object or purpose is hereby approved.

Section 5. Subject to the provisions of this Act and of the Law, and pursuant to the provisions of §30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes or the renewals thereof, and of §§50.00, 56.00 to 60.00 and 168.00 of said Law, the powers and duties of the County Board of Legislators relative to authorizing the issuance of any notes in anticipation of the sale of the bonds herein authorized, or the renewals thereof, relative to providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, relative to prescribing the terms, form and contents and as to the sale and issuance of the respective amounts of bonds herein authorized, and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds or the renewals of said notes, and relative to executing agreements for credit enhancement, are hereby delegated to the Commissioner of Finance of the County, as the chief fiscal officer of the County.

Section 6. Each of the bonds authorized by this Act and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale thereof shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by

§52.00 of said Local Finance Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall be general obligations of the County of Westchester, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the County. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds or the renewals of said notes, and provision shall be made annually in the budgets of the County by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the notes and bonds to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 7. The validity of the bonds authorized by this Act and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

- (a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the County is not authorized to expend money, or
- (b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of this Act or a summary hereof, are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

- (c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.
- Section 8. This Act shall take effect in accordance with Section 107.71 of the Westchester County Charter.
- Section (B). The amendment of the bond act set forth in Section (A) of this act shall in no way affect the validity of the liabilities incurred, obligations issued, or action taken

pursuant to said bond act, and all such liabilities incurred, obligations issued, or action taken shall be deemed to have been incurred, issued or taken pursuant to said bond act, as so amended.

Section (C). This Act shall take effect in accordance with Section 107.71 of the Westchester County Charter.
