The design money doesn't get funded from the origional acts, it gets rolled into the construction money. They are pulling these projects out of the old bundled contract that has multiple projects in it and each new act will be a standalone design, construction management and construction bond. Chair Pierce asked if all of this work will be done at the same time. Commissioner Kopicki responded that yes, there are enough contractors out there that are interested in the work that we are able to put these projects out for bid at the same time.
