1. <u>RES-2023-137</u> <u>PH-Tax Exemption for Volunteer Firefighters and Volunteer</u> Ambulance Services Members

Mr. Adin explained that this Local Law would repeal the current Chapter 475 of the Laws of Westchester County and enact a new Chapter 475. He said that subject to the limitations provided for in the enabling legislation, the new law will authorize a 10% exemption from County real property taxes for volunteer firefighters and volunteer ambulance service

members who: 1) have two or more years of service, 2) reside in the city, town or village served by the volunteer fire company or volunteer ambulance service; and 3) the property is the member's primary residence and the portions of such a primary residence that are used exclusively for residential purposes.
