Dear Members of the Board of Legislators:

Transmitted herewith for your review and approval is an Act to amend the County of Westchester's (the "County") 2020 Capital Budget (the "Capital Budget Amendment") as well as a related bond act (the "Bond Act") in connection with the following capital project:

A042C - Storm Water Management Program ("A042C").

The proposed Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's 2020 Capital Budget to increase the County share for this project by \$3,750,000.

The Bond Act, in the amount of \$3,750,000, would finance the cost of construction and construction management associated with the Outfall No. 7 Storm Drain Replacement project at the Westchester County Airport (the "Airport").

The Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") has advised that this project is required by a New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Order on Consent for water quality violations at the Airport. The Order on Consent requires that the above-specified work must be completed by March 26, 2021.

Design for this project has been completed using outside consultants. It is estimated that construction will take three (3) months to complete and will begin after award and execution of the construction contracts.

It should be noted that your Honorable Board has previously authorized the County to issue bonds for a prior separate component of this capital project as follows: Bond Act No. 49-2020 in the amount of \$1,000,000, which financed the cost of design of new forebays at Basins A & B, the relocation of inlet piping and the dredging of Basin A at the Airport. These bonds have not been sold.

The Planning Department has advised that based on its review, the above-referenced capital project has been classified as a "Type II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQR") and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617. Therefore, no further environmental review is required. As you know, your Honorable Board may use such expert advice to reach its own conclusion.

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmittal from the County Executive recommending approval of an Act to amend the County of Westchester's (the "County") 2020 Capital Budget (the "Capital Budget Amendment"), as well as a related bond act (the "Bond Act") in the amount of \$3,750,000, to finance a component of capital project A042C – Storm Water Management Program ("A042C").

Your Committee is advised that the Capital Budget Amendment will amend the County's 2020 Capital Budget to increase the County share for this project by \$3,750,000.

Your Committee is advised that the related Bond Act, prepared by the law firm of Harris Beach, PLLC, would finance the cost of construction and construction management associated with the Outfall No. 7 Storm Drain Replacement project at the Westchester County Airport (the "Airport").

The Department of Public Works and Transportation ("Department") has advised that this project is required by a New York State Department of Environmental Conservation Order on Consent for water quality violations at the Airport. The Order on Consent requires that the above-specified work must be completed by March 26, 2021.

Design for this project has been completed using outside consultants. It is estimated that construction will take three (3) months to complete and will begin after award and execution of the construction contracts.

It should be noted that your Honorable Board has previously authorized the County to issue bonds for a prior separate component of this capital project as follows: Bond Act No. 49-2020 in the amount of \$1,000,000, which financed the cost of design of new forebays at Basins A & B, the relocation of inlet piping and the dredging of Basin A at the Airport. These bonds have not been sold.

The Planning Department has advised your Committee that based on its review, the above-referenced capital project has been classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQR") and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617. Therefore, no further environmental review is required. Your Committee has reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this conclusion.

In addition, section 167.131 of the County Charter mandates that a capital budget amendment that introduces a new capital project or changes the location, size or character of an existing capital project be accompanied to the Board of Legislators by a report of the Westchester County Planning Board (the "Planning Board") with respect to the physical planning aspects of the project. Accordingly, the necessary Planning Board Report is herewith attached.

Your Committee is advised that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of this Honorable Board is required in order to adopt the Capital Budget Amendment as well as the related Bond Act.

Your Committee has carefully considered both the proposed Capital Budget Amendment and the proposed Bond Act and recommends approval of both of said acts, noting that the Capital Budget Amendment must be approved prior to the Bond Act.



With respect to the State Environmental Quality Review Act and its implementing regulations 6 NYCRR Part 617, the Planning Department recommends that no further environmental review is required for the proposed action, because the project or component of the project for which funding is requested may be classified as a <u>TYPE II action</u> pursuant to section(s):

- 617.5(c)(2): replacement, rehabilitation or reconstruction of a structure or facility, in kind, on the same site, including upgrading buildings to meet building, energy, or fire codes unless such action meets or exceeds any of the thresholds in section 617.4 of this Part.
- 617.5(c)(35): civil or criminal enforcement proceedings, whether administrative or judicial, including a particular course of action specifically required to be undertaken pursuant to a judgment or order, or the exercise of prosecutorial discretion.

COMMENTS: This component involves replacement of the stormwater drainage lines associated with SPDES Outfall 7 to prevent perfluorooctanoic acid (PFOA), perfluorooctane sulfonic acid (PFOS), and other contaminants from entering into the drainage system and discharging out into the Rye Lake watershed as required by NYSDEC pursuant to an Order on Consent (CO 3-20180308-44).

WESTCHESTER COUNTY PLANNING BOARD

Amendment of Planning Board Report of Capital Project A042C Stormwater Management Westchester County Airport

WHEREAS, the County Executive will submit legislation to the County Board of Legislators which would authorize amending an existing capital project A042C Stormwater Management, Westchester County Airport - to fund the construction and construction management for the Outfall No. 7 Storm Drain Replacement project at Westchester County Airport in the amount of \$3,750,000 of County funding; and

WHEREAS, The Department of Public Works and Transportation is advising that this work is a required component of the DEC Order on Consent No. CO 3-20180308-44 for water quality violations at Westchester County Airport; and

WHEREAS, the project is generally consistent with Westchester 2025 – Policies to Guide County Planning, as adopted by the Planning Board on May 6, 2008 and amended on January 5, 2010, in that it will preserve and protect natural resources, control and treat stormwater, and mitigate or reduce the impacts of flooding; now, therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the County Planning Board includes the above-described work in its Report on the 2020 Capital Projects Requests to include the above-described project in A042C Stormwater Management at the Westchester County Airport.

ACT No. 2020

An Act amending the 2020 County Capital Budget Appropriations for Capital Project A042C - Storm Water Management Program

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Westchester as follows:

Section 1. The Capital section of the 2020 County Budget is hereby amended as follows:

Section 3. The ACT shall take effect immediately.

ACT NO. -20

BOND ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,750,000 BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, OR SO MUCH THEREOF AS MAY BE NECESSARY, TO FINANCE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION FOR THE OUTFALL NO. 7 STORM DRAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT AT THE COUNTY AIRPORT; STATING THE ESTIMATED MAXIMUM COST THEREOF IS \$3,750,000; STATING THE PLAN OF FINANCING SAID COST INCLUDES THE ISSUANCE OF \$3,750,000 BONDS HEREIN AUTHORIZED TO FINANCE SUCH COST; AND PROVIDING FOR A TAX TO PAY THE PRINCIPAL OF AND INTEREST ON SAID BONDS. (Adopted, _________, 20__)

BE IT ENACTED BY THE COUNTY BOARD OF LEGISLATORS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK (by the affirmative vote of not less than two-thirds of the voting strength of said Board), AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, constituting Chapter 33-a of the Consolidated Laws of the State of New York (the "Law"), the Westchester County Administrative Code, being Chapter 852 of the Laws of 1948, as amended, to the provisions of other laws applicable thereto, \$3,750,000 bonds of the County, or so much thereof as may be necessary, are hereby authorized to be issued to finance costs of construction for the Outfall No. 7 Storm Drain Replacement Project at the County Airport; all as set forth in the County's current year Capital Budget, as amended. To the extent that the details set forth in this act are inconsistent with any details set forth in the current year Capital Budget of the County, such Budget shall be deemed and is hereby amended. The estimated maximum cost of said specific object or purpose, including preliminary costs and costs incidental thereto and the

financing thereof is \$3,750,000. The plan of financing includes the issuance of \$3,750,000 bonds herein authorized, and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds, and the levy of a tax to pay the principal of and interest on said bonds.

Section 2. The period of probable usefulness applicable to the specific object or purpose for which the bonds authorized by this resolution is to be issued within the limitations of Section 11.00 a. 4 of the Law, is thirty (30) years.

Section 3. Current funds are not required to be provided as a down payment pursuant to Section 107.00 d. 9. of the Law prior to issuance of the bonds authorized herein, or any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale of such bonds. The County intends to finance, on an interim basis, the costs or a portion of the costs of said improvements for which bonds are herein authorized, which costs are reasonably expected to be reimbursed with the proceeds of debt to be incurred by the County, pursuant to this Act, in the maximum amount of \$3,750,000. This Act is a declaration of official intent adopted pursuant to the requirements of Treasury Regulation Section 1.150-2.

Section 4. Subject to the provisions of this Act and of the Law, and pursuant to the provisions of §30.00 relative to the authorization of the issuance of bond anticipation notes or the renewals thereof, and of §\$50.00, 56.00 to 60.00 and 168.00 of said Law, the powers and duties of the County Board of Legislators relative to authorizing the issuance of any notes in anticipation of the sale of the bonds herein authorized, or the renewals thereof, relative to providing for substantially level or declining annual debt service, relative to prescribing the terms, form and contents and as to the sale and issuance of the respective amounts of bonds herein authorized, and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds or the renewals of said notes, and relative to executing agreements for credit enhancement, are hereby

delegated to the Commissioner of Finance of the County, as the chief fiscal officer of the County.

Section 5. Each of the bonds authorized by this Act and any bond anticipation notes issued in anticipation of the sale thereof shall contain the recital of validity prescribed by §52.00 of said Local Finance Law and said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of said bonds shall be general obligations of the County of Westchester, payable as to both principal and interest by general tax upon all the taxable real property within the County. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on said bonds and any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds or the renewals of said notes, and provision shall be made annually in the budgets of the County by appropriation for (a) the amortization and redemption of the notes and bonds to mature in such year and (b) the payment of interest to be due and payable in such year.

Section 6. The validity of the bonds authorized by this Act and of any notes issued in anticipation of the sale of said bonds, may be contested only if:

- (a) such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which the County is not authorized to expend money, or
- (b) the provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of the publication of this Act or a summary hereof, are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity, is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

(c) such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 7. This Act shall take effect in accordance with Section 107.71 of the Westchester County Charter.
