Commissioner Kopicki discussed the item. He said they have a report prepared by one of their consultants that looked at different technologies and recommended they stay with the media system they have now. Some other technologies were too costly or not tried and true. Chair Shimsky asked for a copy of the report. She also asked if the report addresses reducing the volume of media. Commissioner Kopicki said the study, which is included in the report, did bench scale testing and showed they were able to do the same amount of treatment with less volume of media. Chair Shimsky said the committee should vote out the item contingent on receiving the report.

There was a discussion about sewer district consolidation. Deputy Commissioner Federici said the last comprehensive sewer system evaluation by the County was done in the early 1990's. Chair Shimsky said she would like to have the Public Works and Environment committees have an oversight meeting with DEF to discuss this in depth.
