Pursuant to the authority vested in me under Article 2-B of the Executive Law, on August 22, 2021, I, George Latimer, County Executive of the County of Westchester, declared and proclaimed a local State of Emergency in and throughout the County of Westchester beginning at 8:00 am on August 22, 2021, due to a disaster and emergency condition existing by reason of the occurrence of, and imminent threat of, wide spread or severe damage, injury, loss of life and property resulting from Hurricane Henri.

Pursuant to the same authority, I now revoke the local State of Emergency, effective at 5:00 pm on August 25, 2021.
