


**COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER  
LOCAL STATE OF EMERGENCY PROCLAMATION**

Pursuant to the authority vested in me under Article 2-B of the Executive Law, a local state of Emergency is hereby declared and proclaimed in and throughout the County of Westchester beginning at 12:01am hours on the date of September 2, 2021 and ending at 12:01am hours on the date of September 5, 2021.

The State of Emergency has been declared and proclaimed due to a disaster and emergency condition existing by reason of the occurrence of, and imminent threat of, wide spread or severe damage, injury, loss of life and property resulting from the effects of Hurricane Ida.

I, George Latimer, County Executive of Westchester Count hereby find and declare that the aforesaid conditions threaten and imperil the public safety and the safety of the people located in the County of Westchester.

The purpose of this proclamation is to enable the promulgation by the undersigned of specific local emergency orders to protect life and property or to bring the emergency situation under control. This proclamation does not automatically close any County office or facility or impose any restriction except as hereafter specifically set forth in a local emergency order.
