### 4. 2022-484 BOND ACT(Amended)-RGC12, RMUS3, RMUS7, RWPR4

## 5. <u>2022-498</u> <u>IMA (Amend)-Valhalla Fire District</u>

AN ACT to authorize the County of Westchester to amend an intermunicipal agreement with the Valhalla Fire District, for the provision of specialized training and fire suppression services for a two (2) year term, commencing on January 1, 2021 and expiring on December 31, 2022, in an aggregate amount not to exceed NINETY THOUSAND (\$90,000) DOLLARS, in order to increase the not to exceed aggregate amount by ONE HUNDRED SIXTY THOUSAND, SEVEN HUNDRED SIXTY-SEVEN (\$160,767) DOLLARS to compensate the District for the purchase of additional fire suppression equipment.
