Attached for your consideration is an Act, which if enacted by your Board, would authorize the settlement of the lawsuit of <u>Kim Golodetz v County of Westchester et al.</u>, in the amount of \$405,000.00 inclusive of attorney's fees.

This matter is pending in the Westchester County Supreme Court before the Honorable Nancy Quinn Koba. The lawsuit tentatively settled after a verdict on liability, pending this Board's approval of a settlement in the amount of \$405,000.00, inclusive of attorney's fees.

Glenn A. Herman, Esq. of Herman & Herman, P.C., 589 8th Avenue, 21st Floor, New York New York 10018, is representing the plaintiff, Kim Golodetz.

This lawsuit arises out of a bicycle accident on the North County Trailway on April 7, 2019 at approximately 12:40 pm. The plaintiff was travelling north on the trailway when she rode over what she claimed was an unexpected bump and was thrown from her bicycle. At trial plaintiff claimed that the County was negligent for failing to repair the bump despite having notice that another cyclist claimed to have fallen over the identical bump 10 months prior to the plaintiff's accident. The County argued that the bump was not dangerous and that the plaintiff assumed the risk of injury when she voluntarily engaged in cycling on the North County Trailway despite warning signs that there were uneven surfaces. At the conclusion of the liability phase of a bifurcated trial, the jury returned a verdict finding both parties negligent and responsible for the accident. The County was found to be 56% percent responsible and the plaintiff was found to be 44% responsible. The matter settled before the damages phase of the trial where the plaintiff would have presented evidence that, as a result of the accident, she

suffered a fractured shoulder requiring surgery. She claims she engaged in physical therapy for over a year and still suffers from pain and limited range of motion. She alleges that she will require a second surgery to remove the hardware that was put in place during the first surgery because the hardware is causing her to suffer pain.

The settlement takes into consideration the liability findings of the jury, the uncertainty of litigation and the potential costs of trial, subsequent proceedings and potential appeal. AN ACT authorizing the County Attorney to settle the lawsuit of <u>Kim Golodetz v County of</u> <u>Westchester</u>, et al, Westchester County Supreme Court Index No. 61047/2019, in the amount of \$405,000.00, inclusive of attorney's fees

BE IT ENACTED by the Board of Legislators of the County of Westchester as follows:

Section 1. The County Attorney is authorized to settle the lawsuit of <u>Kim Golodetz v.</u>

<u>County of Westchester</u>, et al., Westchester County Supreme Court Index No. 61047/2019, in the amount of \$405,000.00, inclusive of attorney's fees.

Section 2. The County Attorney or his designee is hereby authorized and empowered to execute and deliver all documents and take such actions as the County Attorney deems necessary or desirable to accomplish the purpose of this Act.

Section 3. This Act shall take effect immediately.
