**HONORABLE BOARD OF LEGISLATORS

Your Committee is in receipt of a transmittal from the County Executive recommending approval by the County of Westchester (“County”) of an act amending the County’s current-year capital budget (“Capital Budget Amendment”), as well as adoption of a related bond act (the “Bond Act”) in the amount of \$525,000, which, if approved, would finance design costs associated with capital project SM034 – Anita Lane Bridge Mamaroneck Sanitary Sewer District (“SM034”).

Your Committee is advised that the proposed Capital Budget Amendment, in the amount of \$525,000, is requested to fund the cost of design associated with the rehabilitation of the Anita Lane Bridge located in the Town of Mamaroneck. The total estimated cost for this project is \$3,950,000. This amount will be reflected in the 2025 capital budget year for the proposed 2025 2029 capital plan. Design is being advanced per this request. If approved in 2024, the 2025 requested amount will be reduced accordingly.

Your Committee is further advised that the Bond Act, in the amount of \$525,000, which was prepared by the law firm of Norton Rose Fulbright US, LLP, will finance design costs associated with alterations to the bridge structure to reduce flooding due to the constricting opening size of this bridge. Work will include the removal of the superstructure, including grouted stones, removal of the center pier, existing bridge abutment modification to raise the new truss structure to a higher elevation, temporary support of sewer pipe during construction, streambank stabilization and related work.

Your Committee is advised that following bonding authorization, design will be scheduled and is expected to take approximately eighteen (18) months to complete and will be performed by an outside consultant. It is estimated that construction will take approximately twenty-four (24) months to complete and will begin after award and execution of the construction contracts, subject to your Honorable Board’s further approval of construction funding.

The Planning Department has advised your Committee that based on its review, the above-referenced capital project may be classified as a Type "II" action pursuant to the State Environmental Quality Review Act ("SEQR") and its implementing regulations, 6 NYCRR Part 617. Therefore, no environmental review is required. Your Committee has reviewed the annexed SEQR documentation and concurs with this recommendation.

Additionally, Section 167.131 of the County Charter mandates that a capital budget amendment that introduces a new capital project or changes the location, size or character of an existing capital project be accompanied to the Board of Legislators by a report of the Westchester County Planning Board (the "Planning Board") with respect to the physical planning aspects of the project. Accordingly, the Planning Board report is herewith attached.





It should be noted that an affirmative vote of two-thirds of the members of your Honorable Board is required in order to adopt the Capital Budget Amendment and the related Bond Act, noting that the Bond Act can only be enacted following adoption of the Capital Budget Amendment. For the reasons set forth above, your Committee respectfully recommends the adoption of both of the proposed acts.

SM034 Anita Lane Bridge – Mamaroneck Sanitary Sewer District

WHEREAS, the County Executive will submit legislation to the County Board of Legislators for a Capital Budget Amendment to advance the design funding of capital project **SM034 Anita Lane Bridge – Mamaroneck Sanitary Sewer District**, for design costs associated with reconstruction of this bridge; and

WHEREAS, this project will fund the alterations to the current Anita Lane Bridge, currently used solely as a conduit for carrying a sanitary sewer main, to reduce flooding, due to the constricting opening size of this bridge of the bridge.; and


WHEREAS, work includes the removal of the superstructure including grouted stones, removal of the center pier, existing bridge abutment, modifications to raise the new truss structure to a higher elevation, temporary support of sewer pipe during construction, stream bank stabilization, and related work; and

WHEREAS, the current request is a Capital Budget Amendment to the 2024 Capital Budget to fund the design for \$525,000. The 2025 requested amount for construction and construction management would be reduced if and when this capital budget amendment is approved; and

WHEREAS, this project is consistent with the County Planning Board's long-range planning policies set forth in *Westchester 2025—Context for County and Municipal Planning and Policies to Guide County Planning*, adopted by the Board on May 6, 2008, amended January 5, 2010, and its recommended strategies set forth in *Patterns for Westchester: The Land and the People*, adopted December 5, 1995, as it will maintain existing transportation infrastructure and ease movement on travel routes as well as improve stormwater management; now therefore, be it

RESOLVED, that the County Planning Board, pursuant to Section 167.131 of the County Charter, amends its Report of 2024 Capital Project Requests to include the capital project **SM034 Anita Lane Bridge – Mamaroneck Sanitary Sewer District** with the rating of "PL2HP" and approves funding for design in the amount of \$525,000.

Project Description

This project will fund the alterations to the current Anita Lane Bridge structure to reduce flooding, due to the constricting opening size of this bridge of the bridge. The work includes the removal of the superstructure including grouted stones, removal of the center pier, existing bridge abutment, modifications to raise the new truss structure to a higher elevation, temporary support of sewer pipe during construction, stream bank stabilization, and related work.

2024: Design

2025: Construction management and construction

The current request is for a Capital Budget Amendment to the 2024 Capital Budget to fund the design for \$525,000. The 2025 requested amount for construction and construction management would be reduced if and when this capital budget amendment is approved.

Justification

To build stormwater management capacity and thereby reduce flooding potential in the Village of Mamaroneck.

Consistency with Programs or Plans

This is a programmed project. The proposed project is consistent with "*Westchester 2025*", the County Planning Board's long-range planning policy document, as it will maintain existing transportation infrastructure and ease movement on travel routes.

PL2HP The Planning Board supports the proposed improvements. Planning Department staff will monitor the progress of design to address safety, aesthetic, and environmental planning concerns.

As per Westchester County policy, stormwater management must be addressed with every capital project where feasible. Designs should comply with the latest version of the NYS Stormwater Management Design Manual and the NYS Standards and Specifications for Erosion and Sediment Control.

The Board notes that the Anita Lane Bridge is eligible for listing on the National Register of Historic Places, thus all proposed improvements will be reviewed for consistency with the Secretary of the Interior's Standards for the Treatment of Historic Properties. This project will be referred to the Westchester Historic Preservation Advisory Committee (HPAC) for their review and recommendations.

ACT NO. 177 - 2024

BOND ACT DATED September 30, 2024.

A BOND ACT AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$525,000 BONDS OF THE COUNTY OF WESTCHESTER, NEW YORK, TO PAY DESIGN AND CONSTRUCTION MANAGEMENT COSTS FOR STRUCTURAL IMPROVEMENTS TO ANITA LANE BRIDGE TO REDUCE FLOODING, IN AND FOR THE COUNTY'S MAMARONECK SANITARY SEWER DISTRICT.

WHEREAS, the capital project hereinafter described has been duly approved in the adopted capital budget for the current fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, the plan for the financing of the estimated maximum cost of such capital project, as hereinafter set forth in this Bond Act, is in conformity with such capital budget; and

WHEREAS, all other conditions precedent to the financing of the capital project hereinafter described, including compliance with the provisions of the State Environmental Quality Review Act to the extent required, have been performed; and

WHEREAS, it is now desired to authorize the financing of the cost of such capital project allocable to the County's Mamaroneck Sanitary Sewer District; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ENACTED, by the Board of Legislators of the County of Westchester, New York (the "County"), by the affirmative vote of not less than two thirds of the entire voting strength thereof, as follows:

Section 1. For paying the \$525,000 estimated maximum cost of design and construction management for structural improvements to Anita Lane Bridge to reduce flooding, including incidental expenses in connection therewith, there are hereby authorized to be issued \$525,000 bonds of said County pursuant to the provisions of the Local Finance Law. To the extent that the details of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes set forth in this Bond Act are inconsistent with any details set forth in the current Capital Budget of the County, such Budget shall be deemed and is hereby amended to the extent inconsistent herewith.

Section 2. It is hereby determined that the estimated maximum cost of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes is \$525,000, and that the plan for the financing thereof is by the issuance of the \$525,000 bonds of said County authorized to be issued pursuant to this Bond Act.

Section 3. It is hereby determined that the period of probable usefulness of the aforesaid class of objects or purposes is five years, pursuant to subdivision sixty-two of paragraph a of Section 11.00 of the Local Finance Law.

Section 4. Subject to the provisions of the Local Finance Law, the power to authorize the issuance of and to sell bond anticipation notes in anticipation of the issuance and sale of the bonds herein authorized, including renewals of such notes, is hereby delegated to the Commissioner of Finance, the chief fiscal officer. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Commissioner of Finance, consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 5. The faith and credit of the County are hereby irrevocably pledged for the payment of the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same respectively become due and payable. An annual appropriation shall be made in each year sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations becoming due and payable in such year. To the extent not paid from the assessment of properties assessable for this purpose in the County's Mamaroneck Sanitary Sewer District, as allocated by the County, or other sources, there shall annually be levied on all the taxable real property of said County a tax sufficient to pay the principal of and interest on such obligations as the same become due and payable.

Section 6. Such bonds shall be in fully registered form and shall be signed in the name of the County by the manual or facsimile signature of the Commissioner of Finance and a facsimile of the corporate seal shall be imprinted or impressed thereon and may be attested by the manual or facsimile signature of the County Clerk.

Section 7. The powers and duties of advertising such bonds for sale, conducting the sale and awarding the bonds, are hereby delegated to the Commissioner of Finance, who shall

advertise such bonds for sale, conduct the sale, and award the bonds in such manner as said Commissioner of Finance shall deem best for the interests of the County; including, but not limited to, the power to sell said bonds to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation; provided, however, that in the exercise of these delegated powers, the Commissioner of Finance shall comply fully with the provisions of the Local Finance Law and any order or rule of the State Comptroller applicable to the sale of municipal bonds. The receipt of the Commissioner of Finance shall be a full acquittance to the purchaser of such bonds, who shall not be obliged to see to the application of the purchase money.

Section 8. The Commissioner of Finance is hereby further delegated the power to authorize the sale and issuance of the bonds authorized pursuant to this Bond Act (a) at a discount in the manner authorized by paragraphs e and f of Section 57.00 of the Local Finance Law, (b) at private sale pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Local Finance Law and any regulations of the New York State Comptroller appertaining thereto, including the private sale of bonds at a premium, (c) as capital appreciation bonds or term bonds at public sale or private sale pursuant to the applicable provisions of the Local Finance Law and any regulations of the New York State Comptroller appertaining thereto, and (d) at a variable rate of interest in the manner authorized by Section 54.90 of the Local Finance Law, including notes issued in anticipation thereof. The Commissioner of Finance is hereby authorized to enter into such agreements as said Commissioner of Finance shall determine reasonable and necessary to facilitate the issuance, sale, resale and, or repurchase of such bonds or notes pursuant to the provisions of Section 54.90 of the Local Finance Law. Such bonds and, or notes shall be of such terms, form and contents, and shall be sold in such manner, as may be prescribed by said Commissioner of Finance.

Section 9. The power to issue and sell notes to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation pursuant to Section 169.00 of the Local Finance Law is hereby delegated to the Commissioner of Finance. Such notes shall be of such terms, form and contents as may be

prescribed by said Commissioner of Finance consistent with the provisions of the Local Finance Law.

Section 10. The Commissioner of Finance is hereby further authorized, at the sole discretion of the Commissioner of Finance, to execute a project financing and loan agreement, and any other agreements with the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation and/or the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation, including amendments thereto, and including any instruments (or amendments thereto) in the effectuation thereof, in order to effect the financing or refinancing of the class of objects or purposes described in Section 1 hereof, or a portion thereof, by a bond, and, or note issue of said County in the event of the sale of same to the New York State Environmental Facilities Corporation.

Section 11. The intent of this Bond Act is to give the Commissioner of Finance sufficient authority to execute those applications, agreements, instruments or to do any similar acts necessary to effect the issuance of the aforesaid bonds and, or notes without resorting to further action of this Board of Legislators.

Section 12. All other matters, except as provided herein relating to such bonds, including determining whether to issue such bonds having substantially level or declining annual debt service and all matters related thereto, prescribing whether manual or facsimile signatures shall appear on said bonds, prescribing the method for the recording of ownership of said bonds, appointing the fiscal agent or agents for said bonds, providing for the printing and delivery of said bonds (and if said bonds are to be executed in the name of the County by the facsimile signature of the Commissioner of Finance, providing for the manual countersignature of a fiscal agent or of a designated official of the County), the date, denominations, maturities and interest payment dates, place or places of payment, and also including the consolidation with other issues, shall be determined by the Commissioner of Finance. It is hereby determined that it is to the financial advantage of the County not to impose and collect from registered owners of such bonds any charges for mailing, shipping and insuring bonds transferred or exchanged by the fiscal agent, and,

accordingly, pursuant to paragraph c of Section 70.00 of the Local Finance Law, no such charges shall be so collected by the fiscal agent. Such bonds shall contain substantially the recital of validity clause provided for in Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law and shall otherwise be in such form and contain such recitals in addition to those required by Section 52.00 of the Local Finance Law, as the Commissioner of Finance shall determine.

Section 13. The validity of such bonds and bond anticipation notes may be contested only if:

(1) Such obligations are authorized for an object or purpose for which said County is not authorized to expend money, or

(2) The provisions of law which should be complied with at the date of publication of this Bond Act are not substantially complied with,

and an action, suit or proceeding contesting such validity is commenced within twenty days after the date of such publication, or

(3) Such obligations are authorized in violation of the provisions of the Constitution.

Section 14. This Bond Act shall constitute a statement of official intent for purposes of Treasury Regulations Section 1.150 - 2. Other than as specified in this Bond Act, no monies are, or are reasonably expected to be, reserved, allocated on a long-term basis, or otherwise set aside with respect to the permanent funding of the object or purpose described herein.

Section 15. This Bond Act, which shall take effect immediately in accordance with the provisions of Section 33.10 of the Local Finance Law and as provided in Section 107.71 of the Westchester County Charter, shall be published in summary form in the official newspaper of said County for purposes of this Bond Act, together with a notice of the Clerk of the Board of Legislators in substantially the form provided in Section 81.00 of the Local Finance Law.




