Mr. Abbamont shared photos and discussed the work to be done. Chair Shimsky asked that a sentence be added to the committee report specifying what building and what department this is for. Legislator Barr said that more specificity as to what part of Corrections (i.e., the jail or office space) would be helpful for transparency and to know going forward exactly what work was done. Mr. Abbamont said this is specifically for the Department of Corrections headquarters rooftop air handling unit replacement.

Mr. Abbamont said that 13 of the 16 existing exhaust fans on the roof are non-functioning, and will be replaced. Chair Shimsky asked Mr. Abbamont to provide a narrative on when it was discovered that the exhaust fans were not working, and what was done to remedy the problem. Mr. Abbamont clarified that not all the exhaust fans were non-functioning, and some were abandoned.

7. <u>2022-514</u> <u>ACT-Land Acquisition-36-38 Main Street, Yonkers</u>

Guests: Planning Dept.: Commissioner Norma Drummond, Deputy Commissioner Blanca Lopez, and Program Administrator (Housing & Community Development) Leonard Gruenfeld Commissioner Drummond discussed the project. She noted that the developer was required by the Yonkers Zoning Code to have 66 parking spaces, and will build 34 spaces under the building, and pay Yonkers \$1.2 million (\$35,000 per space) to cover the cost of the City providing parking in the area. Legislator Woodson-Samuels questioned how the community will be affected by this since the area is densely populated. Commissioner Drummond said there are 18 bus lines within a quarter mile of the location, so there might be less of a need for families to have more than one care. She also noted that this is approved locally, and is not a County issue.

Legislators Barr and Williams Johnson also expressed concern about parking issues. Mr. Gruenfeld said there is parking in a shopping center nearby if tenants cannot get parking on site.

Legislator Woodson-Samuels asked if the money that the developer gives to Yonkers in lieu of providing parking spaces go into a CBA. Commissioner Drummond said she was not sure, and will look into it and get back to him.
