Ms. Gasparri discussed the item. Chair Pierce asked for a specific cost breakdown for the HVAC upgrades. Ms. Gasparri said they used the cost estimate from the replacement of air handling units three years ago and added a little escalation, and she can provide that. Chair Pierce also asked to see the expected energy cost savings.

Chair Pierce asked for specifics about the cost breakdown for the ramp service equipment. Ms. Gasparri discussed them, and said she would provide a written cost breakdown. Chair Pierce asked whether it is the same price for the diesel versus electric push-backs. Ms. Gasparri said she will get back to her. Legislator Williams Johnson noticed that the Capital Project Fact Sheet currently states that there are three diesel push-backs, and needs to be changed to reflect that there are two diesel push-backs and one electric. Chair Pierce said that the Committee Report and the page from the Capital Budget Book need to be clarified to reflect that the project includes components for electric vehicle charging stations. Mr. Abbamont said he will reach out to the Budget and Law Departments.

Assistant Commissioner Kvinge discussed the item. He said that most of the requested \$1.5 million in additional funding is due to a shortfall from the municipality's failure to receive an expected \$900,000 DOT grant. Legislator Gashi said the committee report does not include that information and needs to be amended. Chair Pierce asked for a cost breakdown for the revised cost. Mr. Kvinge said there are hundreds of invoices, some of which he has not received yet. They have processed \$3 million in invoices and are expecting another \$1.5 million. He said the project is completed, but they are catching up with paperwork. He said he has the estimate from the engineer, which he will provide. Legislator Maher noted that there should be a completed punchlist, monthly, quarterly, and final requisitions, or other backup. Legislator Gashi asked if someone from the municipality had that information, and Mr. Kvinge said he only received the project engineer's estimate.
