RES-2023-15 Resolution in Opposition to the Discharge of Contaminated Water into the Hudson River

Chair Pierce discussed the importance of the resolution. At Legislator Parker's suggestion, the committee members agreed that the first Whereas clause should specifically name Holtec International as the company decommissioning Indian Point. They also decided that the last Whereas clause should ban the release of radioactive waste into the Hudson River "by Holtec International or any other successor to the decommissioning."

Legislator Parker suggested changing the last Resolved clause which lists who should be sent

a copy of the resolution. The committee agreed to have it sent "to the Westchester County Federal and State delegations, Federal Nuclear Regulatory Committee, State Nuclear Regulatory Committee, and NYS Department of Environmental Conservation."
