Commissioner Norma Drummond from the Planning Department appeared before the Committee to discuss the item. She explained that every year during the course of this five year plan they amend the plan with the specific projects that are going to be undertaken. Legislator Barr asked if one of the requirements is adopting the model ordinance? Commissioner Drummond responded that there is not a requirement for joining the consortium, however, for accepting the funds, they have to do three things. First you have to make sure that your local zoning does not have residency preferences, so you can't give preferences to people who already live in your community on any affordable housing. Second, you have to give the County the Right of First Refusal on any properties that you might want to go to auction. Third, is that you have to have zoning that is friendly to affordable housing. She noted that you do not have to adopt the model ordinances, we put the model ordinances out there as the guidance for what would be affordable housing friendly zoning.

Commissioner Norma Drummond, Deputy Commissioner Blanca Lopez, and Housing Administrator Leonard Gruenfeld from the Planning Department appeared before the Committee to discuss the item. She explained that the board previously approved the use of new homes land acquisition 2.1 million dollars for us to acquire property here in the City of White Plains to create a affordable housing, senior development at 65 Lake Street. The

property was acquired in 2020. Since 2020, requests have gone up significantly, and they are facing a funding gap. The City of White Plains has stepped in and has granted them \$400,000 from their local housing fund. They are here before the BOL to assist them with infrastructure funding under our housing implementation fund program in the amount of \$2,750,000.
