Mr. Vetrone and Ms. Rotini discussed each of the changes in the legislation with the committees.

For Sec. 825.30(3), Chair Pierce asked that the definition of "Construction and Demolition or (C&D)" be changed to make specific reference to Section 826-a.200(8) of the Laws of Westchester County.

For Sec. 825.30(5), the legislators requested that the definition of "Electronic Waste" be changed to delete the following language: "as further defined in New York State Environmental Conservation Law, Article 27, Title 26 and Article 27, Title 23\*2."

For Sec. 825.30(12), the legislators requested that the definition of "Rechargeable Batteries" be changed to alter the state law reference from "Article 27, Title 18 of the New York State Environmental Conservation Law" to "New York State Environmental Conservation Law § 27-1803."

Chair Pierce requested that language be added to Sec. 825.90 to provide that the Board of Legislators shall receive notice of any emergency rule promulgated by the Commissioner.

Legislator Barr asked that information be added to the committee report related to how complaints for violations can be filed with Department of Environmental Facilities.
