Discussion on Artificial Intelligence

Guest:

Greg Rosner- CEO, Pitch Kitchen

Mr. Rosner's presentation on artificial intelligence included information on the different ways that people can optimize its use. Dubbing it as "amplified intelligence," he believes that society can use to their advantage and provided demonstrations through various platforms, such as Hume and ChatGPT 4.0. Hume interacts in a conversation-style form and detects one's feelings or emotions based on a variety of things, such as voice inflections and tone.
