Facilities II. The Bond Act is in the amount of \$1,500,000 to finance a component of capital project BPL40 which will fund a stormwater management project at Edith Read Wildlife Sanctuary and Playland Park in the City of Rye. The current request will fund the design and installation of a living shoreline/artificial reef within the Long Island Sound shoreline. The project will increase the resiliency of the nearby beach and intertidal areas to coastal storms, provide additional habitat for marine life and function as a demonstration project for others to replicate. The Department anticipates that following bonding authorization, this project will take approximately eighteen months to complete.
