The Director of Environmental Planning, Dave Kvinge from the Department of Planning appeared before the Committees to discuss item #2021-258-ENV RES-BPL40-Stormwater Management-Various Co. Facilities II and item #2021-259-BOND ACT-BPL40-Stormwater Management-Various Co. Facilities II. The Bond Act is in the amount of \$1,500,000 to finance a component of capital project BPL40 which will fund a stormwater management project at Edith Read Wildlife Sanctuary and Playland Park in the City of Rye. The current request will fund the design and installation of a living shoreline/artificial reef within the Long Island Sound shoreline. The project will increase the resiliency of the nearby beach and intertidal areas to coastal storms, provide additional habitat for marine life and function as a demonstration project for others to replicate. The Department anticipates that following bonding authorization, this project will take approximately eighteen months to complete. Legislator Shimsky asked a series of questions that the Department said they will follow up on.

The Director of Environmental Planning, Dave Kvinge from the Department of Planning appeared before the Committee to discuss item #2021-268-BPL40-1619-Stormwater Management-Various Co. Fac. II. This bond act is in the amount of \$400,000 to finance a component of capital project BPL40 which will fund a stormwater management project at Oscawana Park in the Town of Cortlandt. The current request will fund the design of the removal of the Maiden Lane dam located within the County-owned Oscawana Park. The dam is in disrepair and the project will reduce flooding conditions in the area and improve fish passage along the Furnace Brook. The Department anticipates that following binding authorization, this project will take approximately eight months to complete.
