The impact of political dividedness on family relationships & friendships and mechanisms of conflict

Guests:

Noura Hajjaj, Lecturer of Communications at SUNY New Paltz, Chair of the Peace and Conflict Communication Division at the National Communication Association & Past President of the New York State Communication Association

Ms. Hajjaj shared a presentation on the inequalities in health care during the COVID-19 pandemic with a focus on Asian-Americans. Within her presentation she provided statistical information as well as the effects of the pandemic on mental health, the impacts of billing in hospitals and the issues surrounding policymakers within the health care system. Additionally, Ms. Hajjaj provided information on hate crimes and the impact that this has on individuals, particularly on those of Asian descent due to COVID-19 misinformation. In her closing remarks, Ms. Hajjaj noted that white privilege has played a role in certain incidents and how it is evidenced within the health care system. The committee members engaged in dialogue on this topic and shared potential steps towards remedying these issues.
