Legislator Pierce said she understands that the work needs to be done, but asked for item breakdowns and cost estimates for the \$1 million requested. Assistant Commissioner Kvinge said they don't have them, and noted that there is a long list of things to be done, and things come up over time so priorities shift. Legislator Gashi said he agrees with Legislator Pierce, and this feels more like an addition to a fund rather than a discrete funding project. Mr. Kvinge said he can provide the information they used to pull the request together. Legislator Barr said that would be helpful, especially going forward, since they will clearly need more money, and there will likely be a master plan in the future. She said we can approve the item contingent to getting that information prior to the next Board meeting. Legislator Pierce also asked Mr. Kvinge to advise what amount of money was left from the money for the fencing project that came in under budget, and he said he would let her know.
