Biography

My name is Tony Kollarmalil. I was born in Kuwait to Indian parents. My father was a power plant engineer & my mother was a nurse. I was raised in Kuwait till the age of 14 when the Gulf War broke out in '91 & we were forced to return to India. I graduated from high school in India & afterwards left to pursue a medical degree in Russia. I spent 9 years in Russia, & completed medical school with a specialization in Emergency medicine. After my education, I returned to India where I worked for the next couple of years before moving to the US in 2007. I became a naturalized citizen in 2019.

I have lived in Yonkers since 2007 with my wife who is a native of Yonkers. She was a Pharmacist at White Plains hospital for several years & now works for NY State Department of Mental Health.

I started out my career in the US at Premier Health Urgent care (now called CityMD) as a clinical workflow improvement specialist. I have since been in population health for several years, first at a startup & now at Columbia University for the past 5 years. I help identify high risk patients that require outreach & work with providers providing education & input on how to improve quality of care while lowering costs.
